Abstract

Health & Family Welfare Department - Self Financing Medical Colleges under Co-operative Sector - fees and admission of students during 2008-09 - Sanction Accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER

Government have discussed the matter of allotment of seats and fees to be levied with the management of the Self Financing Medical Colleges under Co-operative Sector and an agreement is being executed with them for the admissions 2008-09.

2. Sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including the following Medical Colleges, who have entered in to agreement with Government in respect of admission and collection of fees from students to be admitted for MBBS Course 2008-09, in the list of Institutions for allotment of students subject to the terms and conditions specified below: -

Terms and Conditions:

- 1) 50% of the seats in the Member Colleges will be filled up from the list of students qualified in the Common Entrance Test conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations with merit and applying the principles of reservation in Government Colleges.
- 2) The Government shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the management concerned and the management concerned shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid, the amount of refundable deposit to be remitted, and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The management concerned shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Government. The Government shall furnish such lists eligibility conditions as prescribed in the prospectus 2008. Final allotment shall be made on or before the date to be fixed by the Government.
- 3) If any student is not admitted by the management concerned for specific defects or for any reason whatsoever, it shall intimate the Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures.

- 4) The fee for the above 50% seats will be **25,000** per annum or the fees fixed by the Government for Government Medical Colleges. Annual tuition fees for SC/ST/OE/candidates and those candidates eligible for educational and monetary benefits as per G.O.(MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 26.06.2005 will be paid by Government at the rate fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee, appointed by the Government.
- 5) 35% of the total seats will be treated as Management seats with higher fees and will be filled from the list of students qualified in the common entrance test conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 6) Each student thus admitted by the management concerned to the above mentioned 35% seats shall pay annual tuition fees will be Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lakhs only) to the college for which signed receipts with seal shall be given.
- 7) The remaining 15% seats will be filled up by the Management by eligible students, who are children / dependents of Non-Resident Indians. The fees collected from these students will not exceed **Rs.9,00,000/-** (Rupees Nine Lakhs only).
- 8) As per the agreement, the management will not receive cash or kind other than the fee specified.
- 9) The said agreement will be submitted by the Government/Management before the Admission Supervisory Committee, Fee Regulatory Committee and also before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India for approval.

- 10) The member colleges will be entitled to collect uniform fee not exceeding Rs.2,60,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs Sixty thousand only) or the fees fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee in the State from all students excluding those admitted under NRI quota, if the agreement is not approved by the Court or any other competent authority to declare so.
- 11) In the case of any further litigation the above terms and conditions will be subject to the court of Law.
