ORDER

As per the letter read the Commissioner for Entrance Examination has reported that the candidates of Medical/Dental courses tend to file unnecessary options even if they are not likely to join the allotted courses and it will lead to the lapsing of seats. Hence he has requested the Government to incorporate the conditions of liquidated damages to those who do not join the allotted MBBS/BDS seats in the final allotment to self-financing Medical/Dental Colleges.

Government have examined the case in detail and order that the conditions of liquidated damages specified in clause 12.2.4 (a) of the Prospectus for Admission to Professional Courses 2009 shall be applicable to those who do not join the allotted MBBS/BDS seats for the final allotment to Self-financing Medical/Dental Colleges.
