ORDER

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the WP(C)No.934/2014 ordered that it would be just and proper to direct the respondents 2-4 (Secretary to Government, Health & Family Welfare Department, Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram and the Registrar, Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur) to give admission to the petitioner, in relation to the vacant seats in the MBBS course, if any, strictly in accordance with merit of the candidates in the vacant seats. If so, the Hon'ble Court also ordered that the petitioner should be permitted to get transfer in the vacant seat from Self Financing College to the Government College without payment of liquidated damages. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations has reported that presently 4 MBBS seats (3 in Al-Azhar Medical College, Thodupuzha and 1 in Jubilee Mission Medical College, Thrissur) are lying vacant. The Commissioner also reported that admission to MBBS course in the country was completed by 30/09/2014 and the managements concerned have no right on these vacant seats. Therefore, he has reported that it is legitimate on the part of Government to fill up these vacant seats in accordance with the merit of the candidates and requested permission to fill up the 4 MBBS seats under management quota with Government fee prescribed for the Government Medical Colleges in the State.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that permission is given to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram to fill up the above mentioned 4 MBBS seats (3 in Al-Azhar Medical College, Thodupuzha and 1 in Jubilee Mission Medical College, Thrissur) under the management quota with Government fee applicable to the Government Medical Colleges in the State.

3. The Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is thus complied with.
