**CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT TO MBBS, BDS AND MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES**

**ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY**

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to MBBS, BDS courses and third phase of allotment to Medical Allied Courses [Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary & Fisheries] 2016 begins on 02.09.2016 (Friday).

The Candidates who want their higher order options to be considered for this phase of allotment shall have to login to their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can re-arrange /delete their higher order options and also register fresh options to newly added Courses/Colleges from 02.09.2016 to 06.09.2016, 1 pm, through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) . On the basis of options received up to 1 pm on 06.09.2016, the allotment to MBBS, BDS, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary & Fisheries Courses will be published in the evening on 06.09.2016. Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the CEE, in one of the designated branches of the State Bank of Travancore (SBT) or by way of online payment from 07.09.2016 to 09.09.2016. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee, the candidates should join the course/college allotted as per this phase before 5 pm on 09.09.2016. **Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the allotment to Medical and Allied Courses and also their higher options in Medical & Allied courses will not be available in the subsequent phases.** However his/her existing allotment shall be retained.

The "Option Facilitation Centres" [OFC] and "Help Desks" [HD], having internet facility, will be functioning throughout the State during this period for providing necessary help to the candidates for registration of options. 07.09.2016 to 09.09.2016	Candidates who receive allotment should remit the fee /balance fee payable in SBT or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
09.09.2016, 5.30 pm	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

The schedule for further allotments, if any, will be notified in due course.

\* This fee concession benefit will be available to the candidates only after completion of allotment process. Hence candidates should remit the full fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at the time of allotment. Balance fee will be refunded to the candidates after the completion of allotment process.

## Token Deposit :

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC Community category and those having benefit as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005, have to remit token deposit at the rates mentioned below, as token of having accepted the allotment:

1. MBBS/BDS courses : Rs. 1000/-
2. Other Courses : Rs. 100/-

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

**Note:** Candidates admitted in Govt./ Aided/ Govt. Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses only after paying the liquidated damages as per clause 12.2.4 of the Prospectus-2016 and orders issued by the Government.

Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to Medical & Allied Courses subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No.252/2014/H.Edn. Dated: 07.06.2014.

While issuing Transfer Certificate and other documents to the candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges consequent to the allotment through KEAM 2016, liquidated damages shall not be collected as per GO(Ms) No.155/2016/H.Edn. Dated: 30.06.2016 and GO(Rt) No.1686/2016/H.Edn. Dated: 30.06.2016. But the fees remitted for the year need not be refunded.

**Important:** Those candidates who seek admission under Minority Community quota, if available in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges having Minority Status also shall have to submit online options to the desired courses/colleges along with other students.
