SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO ENGINEERING/ARCHITECTURE/PHARMACY COURSES-2017 ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to Professional Degree Courses (Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy)-2017 will begin on **06.07.2017**. Government have accorded sanction to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations to make allotment to the Government seats in B.Pharm course in the Self Financing Pharmacy colleges which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the Government. So in the second phase, allotment will be done to the newly included Engineering/Architecture courses and the Self Financing Pharmacy colleges also. The Candidates who want their higher order options in Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy courses to be considered in the second phase of allotment shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available therein. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options or delete the unwanted options and also register fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges from **06.07.2017** to **09.07.2017, 9 am**, through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. On the basis of options received up to **9 am** on **09.07.2017**, the second phase allotment will be published in the evening on **10.07.2017**. Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their second phase allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the CEE, in one of the designated branches of the State Bank of India (SBI) or by way of online payment on any date from **11.07.2017** to **14.07.2017**. The list of designated branches of SBI is available on the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee in any of the designated branches of SBI or by way of Online Payment, the candidates should join the course/college allotted in the second phase.

DETAILED SCHEDULE FOR THE SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

06.07.2017	Website opens for Online Option Confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options and registration of fresh options to the newly added Courses/Colleges.
09.07.2017 (9 am)	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion/addition of options ends
10.07.2017	Publication of Second Phase Allotment
11.07.2017 to 14.07.2017	Candidates who have received allotment should remit the fee/balance fee payable in SBI or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course.
14.07.2017 (5 pm)	All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase allotment and also their higher order options in Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy streams will not be available in the subsequent phases. However his/her existing allotment shall be retained if he/she has remitted the required fee as per the first phase allotment. Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for being considered in the second phase of allotment for both candidates allotted with a course in the first phase and those who have not received any allotment in the first phase.

The following Engineering/architecture courses in the colleges concerned have been newly included provisionally in the second phase of allotment, for which fresh options can be filed by candidates.

Token Deposit:

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have to remit token deposit of Rs. 1000/- as token of having accepted the allotment:

The candidates getting allotment are liable to remit the fee fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee if the fee fixed on the basis of agreement between Government and Self-financing Managements is not approved by the Hon'ble Court or any competent authority.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities.

Note: The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they produce the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before 5 pm on 08.07.2017.
