ADMISSION TO ENGINEERING/ARCHITECTURE/PHARMACY COURSES-2017
SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The Second phase allotment to Professional Degree Courses (Engineering, Architecture and Pharmacy)-2017 is published on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate. The candidates should take a printout of the second phase allotment memo and produce it before the authorities of **State Bank of India (SBI)** for payment of fee/balance fee. The list of designated branches of **SBI** is available on the website. The fee/balance fee can be paid by way of **Online Payment** also.

Candidates who receive an allotment afresh should remit the fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the second phase allotment memo at any of the designated branches of **State Bank of India** or by way of **Online Payment** on any date from **11.07.2017 to 14.07.2017** and should join the course/college allotted before **5 pm on 14.07.2017**.

The candidates who get a change in allotment than that of the first allotment should pay the balance fee, if applicable, in a designated branch of **SBI** or by way of **Online Payment** on any date from **11.07.2017 to 14.07.2017** and should join the course/college allotted as per the second phase allotment memo before **5 pm on 14.07.2017**.

Thus all the candidates who have an allotment after the second phase should join the course/college allotted as per the second phase allotment memo before **5 pm on 14.07.2017**. The detailed schedule showing the date and time for joining the Engineering/Architecture courses is published in the website www.cee-kerala.org. The candidates who are not able to join the course/college as per the schedule can join the college before **5 pm on 14.07.2017** by intimating the college authorities concerned.

Candidates who have an allotment can download the 'Candidate's Data Sheet' containing the basic details of the candidates by clicking the menu item '**Data Sheet**' available in the home page of the candidate. The printout of this Data Sheet is to be produced before the college authorities at the time of admission.

Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee and who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as all the existing options in the stream to which the allotment belongs.

No allotments have been done to the seats earmarked under Community/Registered Trust/Registered Society Quota in Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges and to the Minority Quota seats in Private Self Financing Pharmacy colleges in this phase. The allotment to such seats shall be done in the third phase after publishing and finalizing the list of candidates who have applied under such quota.

The allotments done on the basis of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala to the new courses/additional intake in some Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges and to certain Private Self Financing Pharmacy colleges shall be provisional and subject to the final out come of the related Writ Petitions.

The third phase of Allotment to Professional Degree courses will be published on 20th July, 2017. Facility for **online option confirmation** and for rearranging the existing options/deleting the unwanted options/filing of fresh options to the new courses and colleges, if any, will be provided before the third round of allotment.
