ADMISSION TO THE MINORITY QUOTA SEATS IN PRIVATE SELF FINANCING MEDICAL & DENTAL COLLEGES
DOCUMENTS TO PROVE MINORITY COMMUNITY INVITED FROM STUDENTS

As per GO(Rt) No. 2183/2017/H&FWD dated 03.08.2017, Candidates belonging to Minority Community seeking admission to the seats earmarked for Minority Quota under MBBS/BDS courses in Private Self Financing Medical Dental colleges shall have to submit Minority/Community Certificates obtained from Revenue Officials to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as proof for the claim. These seats shall be filled up by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the students belonging to the respective Minority Communities based on inter-se merit during the second phase of counselling to the Medical and Allied courses scheduled to be conducted from 08.08.2017 to 18.08.2017.

Candidate who wish to seek admission under Minority Quota seats in the Private Self Financing Medical and Dental colleges having Minority Status shall have to log into the home page of the candidate through the link 'KEAM 2017-Candidate Portal' provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and should click the menu item 'Minority Quota' available therein. Then a list of community categories belonging to the Minority Community along with the criteria of eligibility, documents to be furnished for claiming Minority Quota are displayed. In addition, proforma of the Community Certificate to be submitted in respect of each community category and the proforma for basic details of the candidate are available for download against the community concerned. Candidates should fill up the proforma for basic details and should submit the same, along with the Minority/Community certificate obtained from Revenue Officials to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, 5th Floor, Housing Board Buildings, Santhi Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram -695 001 before 5 pm on 11.08.2017, by Registered Post/Speed Post/Hand Delivery.

Candidates who wish to be allotted under a particular Minority category shall have to submit the exact document specified for the same. The Provisional category-wise list of students who furnish the required documents within the stipulated time shall be prepared and published in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for verification by the students. Complaints, if any, with regard to the Provisional category wise lists will be invited and the final category lists will be published prior to the publication of the allotment. Community Certificates issued by the Revenue authority alone shall be considered for claims under Minority Quota. Defective and incomplete certificates shall not be considered. Candidates should ensure before sending the documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations that the Community certificates are signed by the Authority concerned and proper seal is affixed in it.

Note:-

1. Candidates belonging to Muslim community who have submitted Non-Creamy Layer Certificate obtained from Revenue Officials along with application for KEAM 2017 and who have been included in the category lists for Medical courses need not submit community certificate again for inclusion under Muslim Minority Category.
2. Candidates belonging to Muslim Community who submit the community certificate prescribed for Muslim candidates from Malabar area shall be included under all Muslim category. They need not submit separate community certificate for being included under all Muslim category.
3. Candidates seeking admission to MBBS/BDS courses under Minority Quota shall also have to submit online options like other candidates, to the Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges having minority status, while online options are invited to these colleges.
4. On receipt of the details of Minority Community in other Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, candidates will be given facility to submit Minority/Community Certificate to these colleges also. Candidates are instructed to take note of the notifications in this regard.
