**CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES PUBLISHED**

The third phase of allotment to MBBS, BDS Courses and second phase of allotment to Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges is published herewith in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). In this phase, allotment is done only to Government Medical/Dental Colleges and Self Financing Medical/Dental Colleges. This allotment is done on the basis of the interim order dated 22.08.2017 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala on WP(C) No. 22117/2017(L) & connected cases and as per GO(Rt) No. 2343/2017/H&FWD dated 23.08.2017.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate and will be shown in the allotment memo. The candidates should invariably take a printout of the allotment memo.

Those candidates who receive an allotment afresh or a change in allotment than the previous one to MBBS/BDS courses shall have to report for joining at **Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram on 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup> of August 2017** with all the original documents along with Demand Draft for the requisite amount of fee/balance fee, if any, to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo, drawn in favour of **Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Thiruvananthapuram** payable at Thiruvananthapuram along with Bank Guarantee/Bond if applicable. Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee and who do not report for joining the college allotted in the above venue within **4 pm 29.08.2017** will lose their allotment.

Candidates who have submitted the Demand Draft for the requisite fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before 24.08.2017 pursuant to the allotment published on 19.08.2017 and who have no change in allotment also have to report for joining at **Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram on 28<sup>th</sup> or 29<sup>th</sup> August 2017** with all the documents.

\* Annual fee for 10 students out of this 50% seats belonging to BPL/Lower Income Group shall be Rs. 25,000/- and 13 students belonging to SEBC shall be Rs. 45,000/-

\*\* Annual fee for 6 students out of this 50% seats belonging to BPL/Lower Income Group shall be Rs. 23,000/- and 8 students belonging to SEBC shall be Rs. 44,000/- This fee concession will be implemented after the completion of admissions. Hence, these students also have to remit fee at par with other students at the time of admission.

# Bond should be prepared in the prescribed format in stamp paper acquired in the name of candidate/parent and need not be attested by Notary or Gazetted Officer.

The Fee structure in Self Financing Medical Colleges shall be subject to the final decision of the Hon'ble High Court/Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC)

**Conditions of Liquidated Damages for leaving the Engineering/Architecture/ Pharmacy courses:**

1. Candidates admitted in Govt./Aided/Govt.Controlled Self Financing Engineering Colleges and leaving the course after the closing date of admission for Engineering courses shall be liable to pay Liquidated Damages as per Clause 12.2.4(a) of the Prospectus for KEAM 2017.
2. Candidates admitted in Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges under Kerala Catholic Engineering College Managements Association can accept the new allotment to MBBS/BDS Courses subject to the conditions in GO(Ms) No.166/2017/H.Edn. Dated: 22.06.2017.
3. While issuing Transfer Certificate and other documents to the candidates admitted in other Private Self Financing Engineering/Architecture colleges consequent to the allotment to MBBS/BDS courses through KEAM 2017, liquidated damages shall not be collected as per GO(Ms) No.170/2017/H.Edn. Dated: 23.06.2017 and GO(Ms) No.169/2017/H.Edn. Dated: 23.06.2017. But the fee remitted for the year need not be refunded.
4. The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala as per Order dated 21.08.2017 on WP(C) No. 27106/2017 has extended the closing date of admission to Pharmacy courses to 30.09.2017. Hence candidates admitted in Govt./Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges and leaving the course before 30.09.2017 need not pay Liquidated Damages.

Allotment has been done to the Minority Quota seats (including the minority seats under NRI quota) in Private Self Financing Medical/Dental Colleges having minority status in this phase.

The Kerala University of Health Sciences has intimated that allotment can be done to Karuna Medical College, Palakkad, Kannur Medical College, Anjarakkandi, Kannur, Malabar Medical College Hospital & Research Centre, Kozhikode and SUT Academy of Medical Sciences, Thiruvananthapuram. Hence allotment has been done to the above four colleges in this phase.

The vacant seats, if any, remaining after 4 pm on 29.08.2017 shall be filled up through a Spot Admission to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram on 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017. The Spot Admission will be for filling up the vacant seats in MBBS/BDS courses only. Candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Spot Admission shall have to join the allotted colleges then and there itself, after remitting the required fee as above. During Spot Admission also all the Medical/Dental college authorities shall be present at the venue of the Spot Admission for completing the admission procedure. Candidates who attend the Spot Admission scheduled to be held on 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017 are also directed to submit the originals of all the documents including Transfer Certificate for taking admission along with Demand Draft for the requisite amount and Bank Guarantee/Bond (if applicable).

The vacant seats, if any, remaining in BDS course after 31.08.2017 shall be filled up through a Spot Admission to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at Thiruvananthapuram on 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2017 in accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala dated: 25.08.2017 on WP(C) No. 28347/2017.

**Online registration for Spot Admission**

Candidates who wish to participate in the Spot Admission process to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at Thiruvananthapuram shall have to register online through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from 28.08.2017 to 29.08.2017, 5 pm. Such candidates will be issued with a 'Spot Admission Slip' which can be downloaded from the webpage. Candidates who produce the 'Spot Admission Slip' alone shall be permitted to participate in the Spot Admission. Candidates possessing Transfer Certificate and all the original documents to prove educational qualifications alone shall be permitted to attend the Spot Admission.

**Online registration for candidates outside Kerala**

Candidates who seek admission to the seats earmarked for candidates outside Kerala in certain Private Self Financing Medical Colleges shall have to register online through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from 28.08.2017 to 29.08.2017, 5 pm. The allotment to these seats shall also be done in the Spot Admission to be

held on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017. During online registration, they will be issued with a 'Spot Admission Slip' which can be downloaded from the webpage. Such candidates are required to be present during the Spot Admission along with the 'Spot Admission Slip', original documents to prove educational qualifications, Transfer Certificate, documents to prove minority community status and the required documents to prove NRI claims (see office notifications dated 22.07.2017 & 31.07.2017).

**Admission of Candidates to Karuna Medical College, Palakkad as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 22.03.2017**

The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 22.03.2017 in SLP(C) No. 32580-32581 of 2016 have ordered to admit the 30 students found eligible by ASC in case of Karuna Medical College, Palakkad who have been illegally deprived of their admission in spite of being meritorious, in the next academic session 2017-18. The admission of these 30 candidates shall be done on 28.08.2017 and 29.08.2017 at the **Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram**. Hence these 30 candidates shall have to be present on the above dates and venue for completing the admission procedure with all the relevant documents including Transfer Certificate to prove their claim and the requisite fee as shown in the table above. The non-join vacancies as on 29.08.2017, 4 pm shall be deemed as vacant seats and will be filled up in the Spot Admission on 30<sup>th</sup> & 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017.

The Medical Council of India had denied admission for the year 2017-18 to the following colleges viz. Al Azhar Medical College & Super Speciality Hospital, Ezhalloor, Thodupuzha, Idukki, DM Wayanad Institute of Medical Sciences, Kalpetta, Meppadi P.O., Wayanad and Mount Zion Medical College, Chayalode, Adoor, Pathanamthitta. The Hon'ble High Court of Kerala vide orders dated 25.08.2017 on WP(C) No. 19753, 27307 & 28258/2017 have directed the State Government to allow these colleges to participate in the allotment process provisionally subject to further orders in the writ petitions. In the circumstances, allotment shall be done to the above three Private Self Financing Medical colleges during the Spot Admission to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2017 at the Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College campus, Thiruvananthapuram. But the allotment to these colleges shall be provisional and subject to the final orders of the Hon'ble Court.

28<sup>th</sup> of August 2017 being a Calendar Holiday, all the Educational institutions including Technical Institutions and Arts & Science colleges under the department of Higher Education and the Department of Health & Family Welfare have been given strict orders to function on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2017 so as to facilitate the issue of Transfer Certificate and other documents to the already admitted candidates. The respective Government Orders are available in the website.
