MOP-UP COUNSELING FOR MBBS/BDS COURSES
REVISED NOTIFICATION

The Mop-up counselling (Spot Admission) to fill up the vacant seats in MBBS and BDS courses shall be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at **Old Auditorium inside Government Medical College Campus, Thiruvananthapuram** on 4th and 5th of September 2018. The mop-up counselling will start at 9 am on 04.09.2018 and will continue on 06.09.2018, in case the counselling is not completed on 05.09.2018.

As per the orders dated: 30.08.2018 in WP(C)Nos. 20996, 19449, 19543 & 19386 of 2018, the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala have permitted to make allotments to MBBS course in the following 4 Private Self Financing Medical Colleges viz, *Al-Azhar Medical College & Super Speciality Hospital, Ezhalloor, Thodupuzha, Idukki, DM Wayanad Institute of Medical Sciences, Kalpetta, Meppadi P.O., Wayanad, P K Das Institute of Medical Sciences, Vaniyamkulam, Ottapalam, Palakkad, S R Medical College and Research Centre, Akathumuri, Thiruvananthapuram*. The allotments to the above Medical colleges shall also be done in the Mop-up counselling scheduled to be held on 4th & 5th of September 2018. Considering the rise in the number of seats to be filled up in the Mop-up counselling, the Government have granted permission to invite online options from students prior to Mop-up counselling in addition to online registration as notified earlier, and to conduct Mop-up counselling based on the online options received.

Filing of online options for Mop-up counselling is mandatory

Candidates who wish to participate in the Mop-up counselling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at Thiruvananthapuram shall have to register online options through the link '**Option Registration for Mop-up**' in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations **before 6 pm on 03.09.2018**. Such candidates will be issued with a '**Mop-up counselling Slip**' which can be downloaded from the webpage. The allotments to MBBS and BDS courses in the Mop-up counselling shall be on the basis of the priority of online options filed by the candidates and as per the eligibility of the candidates strictly adhering to the guidelines for mop-up counselling as detailed below. Accordingly, a candidate presently admitted to MBBS course in a Government Medical College shall not be permitted to file options in respect of any other Government Medical college. Similarly, a candidate presently admitted to MBBS course in a Self Financing Medical College shall not be permitted to file options in respect of any other Self Financing Medical college and so on. While filing online options, candidates are advised to file options only to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted. Candidates are also advised to file options in advance to the courses/colleges of their choice in which fresh vacancies may be created during Mop-up counselling. Candidates should present themselves for the Mop-up counselling with the printout of online options filed and the **Mop-up counselling Slip**.

Note: Candidates who have already registered for Mop-up counselling and taken Mop-up counselling slip from the website should also file online options through the website before 6 pm on 03.09.2018.

Important:

- 1) Candidates are bound to accept the allotment received as per the options filed by them in the Mop-up counselling. Otherwise, such candidates shall not be considered for further processing in the Mop-up counselling.
- 2) The priority of options filed by the candidates for Mop-up counselling **before 6 pm on 03.09.2018** cannot be altered at any stage of the Mop-up counselling. Hence, candidates are advised not to file unnecessary options for Mop-up counselling.

Candidates who get allotment to MBBS or BDS course in Mop-up counselling shall have to join the allotted college then and there itself, after remitting the required fee. During Mop-up counselling, all the Medical/Dental college authorities in the State shall be present at the venue of the Mop-up counselling for completing the admission procedure.

Guidelines for Mop-up counselling

- (i) In the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Government Medical College to another Government Medical College or for students admitted in a Self Financing Medical College to another Self Financing Medical College.
- (ii) In the mop-up counselling, transfer will not be permitted to students admitted in a Government Dental College to another Government Dental College or for students admitted in a Self Financing Dental College to another Self Financing Dental College.
- (iii) Transfer will be permitted in the mop-up counselling to students admitted in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges to Government Medical/Dental colleges and vice-versa.
- (iv) Transfer from NRI seat to Government/Minority seat shall be permitted between two Self Financing colleges or in the same college, even if it is for the same course.

Details of Fee and mode of remittance:

Candidates getting allotment during the mop-up counselling shall have to remit the fee as given below at the venue of Mop-up counselling by way of Demand Draft drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.

- 1) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS course in Government Medical Colleges- **Rs. 25,000/-**.
- 2) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course in Government Dental Colleges-**Rs. 23,000/-**.
- 3) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS course under Government/Minority/NRI quota in Self Financing Medical Colleges- **Rs.5 lakhs**.
- 4) Candidates getting allotment to BDS course under Government/Minority/NRI quota in Self Financing Dental Colleges- **Rs.3 lakhs**.
- 5) Candidates getting allotment to MBBS/BDS courses who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Registered Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 - **Rs. 1000/-**.
- 6) Candidates, who have remitted any fee amount to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as per the allotment, if any, already received under Medical & Allied courses need submit the Demand Draft for the balance amount only.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Mop-up Counselling:

Candidates who wish to participate in the mop-up counselling shall have to register online options through the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then appear in person for the mop-up counselling with the following documents.

- 1) Mop-up counselling Slip
- 2) Print out of option list
- 3) Demand Draft for the requisite amount
- 4) Candidates who are not admitted to any of the courses at present may produce the original Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended, Conduct Certificate and Original mark list(s) of the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary or equivalent) along with the Pass certificate of the qualifying examination (if issued).
- 5) Candidates allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and admitted to courses other than MBBS/BDS shall have to produce the **self- attested copies of all the certificates showing his/her educational qualifications** and a **'Possession Certificate'** obtained from the Head of the institution in which the candidate is presently admitted, stating that the original documents of the candidate including Transfer Certificate is under the safe custody of the institution.
- 6) Candidates who are not allotted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations but presently admitted to any other course shall have to produce the **self- attested copies of all the certificates showing his/her educational qualifications**, a **'No Objection Certificate'** obtained from the Head of the institution in which the candidate is presently admitted, stating that the institution has no objection in relieving the candidate and a **'Possession Certificate'** obtained from the Head of the institution presently admitted, stating that the original documents of the candidate including Transfer Certificate is under the safe custody of the institution.

- 7) Eligibility certificate from any University in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE.
- 8) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- 9) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- 10) Data sheet of KEAM 2018.
- 11) Physical Fitness Certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure XVII (b) of the Prospectus 2018.
- 12) Candidates who seek admission under NRI quota shall have to produce the original documents to prove NRI claim (see the office notifications dated 22.11.2017 and 14.06.2018 available in the website).

Submission of fresh NRI documents to claim un availed seats under NRI quota:

As per GO(Rt) No.2647/2018/H&FWD dated: 21.08.2018, in case candidates are not available from the NRI category list already published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for admission to MBBS/BDS courses, candidates who submit the required NRI documents in original afresh shall be considered for the un availed seats under NRI quota. Candidates who could not submit the NRI documents in time for inclusion in the NRI category list and those who were not included in the NRI category list due to the defects in their submitted NRI documents can submit the NRI documents mentioned in the office notification dated 14.06.2018, afresh during the Mop-up counselling for claiming the un availed seats under NRI quota. Such candidates will be considered only after the NRI category list already published is exhausted. One set of photocopy of the NRI documents should also be submitted along with the original NRI documents.

NEET qualified candidates outside KEAM 2018 rank list will be considered for un availed seats in the Mop-up counselling:

As per the direction received vide letter no. S3/48/2018-Health dated 28.08.2018, from the Government, those NEET qualified students who were not able to get registered in the KEAM rank list for Medical courses in time due to various reasons shall be allowed to attend Mop-up counselling for the vacant seats, if any, even after the main KEAM rank list got exhausted. Candidates qualified in the NEET(UG) 2018, who satisfy the eligibility conditions with regard to Nativity, Academic qualifications and Age as per clause 6 of the Prospectus and who are not included in the KEAM 2018 rank list for Medical courses due to various reasons can attend the Mop-up counselling for MBBS/BDS courses subject to the following conditions.

- a) Candidates who belong to either Keralite or Non-Keralite Category-I (NK-I) category alone shall be considered for the un availed seats.
- b) Such candidates shall have to produce the document(s) in original to prove their Nativity (as per clause 6.1.1 of the prospectus), Academic eligibility and Age.
- c) Candidates who have not remitted Application Fee under KEAM 2018 shall have to remit an Application fee of Rs. 500/- by way of Demand Draft from a Nationalized Bank drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.
- d) Such candidates need report at the Mop-up counselling venue at 2.pm on 04.09.2018 only with all the original documents and one set of photo copy of the documents.
- e) Such candidates will be considered only after the KEAM rank list already published is exhausted.
