ADMISSION TO THE MINORITY QUOTA SEATS IN PRIVATE SELF FINANCING
MEDICAL & DENTAL COLLEGES
DOCUMENTS TO PROVE MINORITY COMMUNITY INVITED FROM STUDENTS

As per GO(Rt) No. 2016/2018/H&FWD dated 23.06.2018 and GO(Rt) No. 2031/2018/H&FWD dated 25.06.2018, a portion of the MBBS/BDS seats in the Private Self Financing Medical & Dental colleges in the State having Minority Status have been earmarked for the students belonging to the Minority Community to which the Management of the Institution belongs. These seats shall be filled up by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the students belonging to the respective Minority Communities based on inter-se merit through the Centralised Allotment Process (CAP-2018).

Candidates who wish to seek admission under Minority Quota seats in the Private Self Financing Medical and Dental colleges having Minority Status shall have to log into the home page of the candidate through the link '**KEAM 2018-Candidate Portal**' provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and should click the menu item '**Minority Quota**' available therein. Then a list of community categories belonging to the Minority Community will be displayed. The criteria of eligibility and documents to be furnished by candidates for claiming Minority Quota are also displayed. In addition, proforma of the Community Certificate to be submitted in respect of each community category is available for download against the community category concerned. Candidates should obtain the community certificate from the authority mentioned against the respective category in this downloaded proforma and should upload the same, along with the Minority/Community certificate obtained from Revenue Officials (if needed) through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations before **5 pm on 29.06.2018**. The relevant Government Orders showing the availability of Minority Quota seats in such colleges, the details of Minority Community, the criteria for eligibility for such seats and the documents to be submitted as proof for the claim are available in the websites www.cee.kerala.gov.in and www.cee-kerala.org of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates who wish to be allotted under a particular Minority category shall have to upload the exact document specified for the same. Candidates who do not upload the required document(s) specified for a particular Minority sub-category within the time notified shall not be included in the category-wise list for the said minority category. The Provisional category-wise list of students who upload the required documents within the stipulated time shall be prepared and published in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for verification by the students. Complaints, if any, with regard to the Provisional category wise lists will be invited and the allotment to these seats shall be made after the publication of the final category lists.

Community Certificates issued by the authority designated to issue the certificates as mentioned in the Government Orders alone shall be considered for claims under Minority Quota. Defective and incomplete certificates shall not be considered. Candidates should ensure before uploading the documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations that the Community certificates are signed by the Authority concerned and proper seal is affixed in it.

Important: Candidates who seek admission under Minority quota seats in the Self Financing Medical and Dental colleges shall have to register options online to these colleges along with other students during the time of online option registration. Also candidates who wish to get admission in the NRI quota seats earmarked for the Minority community candidates in such colleges shall have to register options under NRI Quota in these colleges. Candidates who do not register options shall not be considered for allotment under Minority quota even if they are included in the Minority category list.

The facility for submission of online options shall be available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in upto 10 am on 29.06.2018.

Note: Candidates who have submitted Non-Creamy layer certificate from the Village Officer along with the application for KEAM-2018 and already included in the Muslim (MU) category list for SEBC reservation published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations shall be included in the Muslim Minority category list to be certified by Revenue officials and will be considered for allotment under Muslim Minority quota. Such candidates need not upload Caste Certificate from the revenue officials through the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations again.

The details of availability of Minority quota seats in Self Financing Medical & Dental colleges, the details of Minority community, the criteria of eligibility and documents to be furnished by candidates for claiming Minority Quota are also are appended as Annexure to this notification.

Condition of Bond: In the case of Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Ernakulam (MMC), Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Science & Research Centre, Thiruvalla(PMC) and Believers Church Medical College Hospital, Kuttapuzha, Thiruvalla(BCM), candidates seeking admission under Minority Quota (including Minority seats under NRI quota) shall have to execute a bond to the extent that candidate should serve 1 year in the institution concerned immediately after the successful completion of the course.
