GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS & BDS COURSES UNDER NRI QUOTA

As per the communication dated 10.03.2017 from the Ministry of Health, Government of India, letter dated 11.04.2017 from the Government of Kerala and as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 31.03.2017 on WP (C)No. 99/2017 and connected cases, the admission to the entire MBBS, BDS seats including those under Minority Quota/NRI Quota in the Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges in the State shall be done through a Centralised Counseling to be done by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the Kerala State Merit list to be prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on the basis of NEET (UG)-2018 score. The Kerala State Merit list shall be prepared by including the candidates who have qualified in NEET (UG)-2018 and have submitted application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM 2018. Those candidates who satisfy the Nativity conditions as specified in Clause 6.1 of the Prospectus for KEAM 2018 alone shall be included in the Kerala State Merit list for MBBS/BDS admissions. All the candidates included in the above list shall be considered for allotment/admission to the Government seats in MBBS/BDS courses.

Eligibility for admission under NRI Quota:

“An applicant, who depends upon his/her Father/Mother/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad” is eligible to apply under NRI Quota.

Documents to be submitted:

Candidates seeking admission to the 15% NRI Quota MBBS/BDS seats in Self Financing Medical/Dental Colleges shall have to submit the following documents before the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as and when required.

- 1) Relationship certificate of the Sponsor and student to be issued by the Revenue Authorities as per GO(MS) No. 243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.
- 2) Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer, attested by the Embassy and if self employed, it should also be attested by the Embassy. In the case of non-submission of Embassy Certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment by the Embassy/Consulate shall be accepted. Certificate issued by the Embassy/Consulate stating that the Sponsor is a Non Resident Indian (NRI) or an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or the Green Card documents shall be accepted in lieu of the Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer and attested by the Embassy.
- 3) Passport with Visa stamped on it and attested by the Embassy
- 4) A self affidavit of the relationship between sponsor and the candidate (Sponsorship Certificate)
- 5) The sponsor should be an Indian Citizen/Overseas citizen of India/Person of Indian Origin and relevant document to prove the same.

The availability of Minority Quota seats in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, the details of the Minority Community and the documents to be produced before the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for availing the Minority Quota seats etc. shall be published later.

Candidates without proper proof for claim of Minority/NRI Quota shall neither be included in the respective category lists nor be considered for allotment/admission.
