ENGINEERING/ARCHITECTURE/PHARMACY/AYURVEDA/ MEDICAL & ALLIED RANK LISTS, KERALA 2018 - PUBLISHED

The rank lists for admission to Engineering, Architecture, Pharmacy, Ayurveda, Medical & Allied Courses 2018 are published herewith. The rank details will be available on the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

The Entrance Examination for Engineering courses 2018 was conducted on 23rd (Paper-I: Physics & Chemistry) and 24th (Paper - II: Mathematics) of April 2018. The scores obtained by the candidates in the Engineering Entrance Examination were published on 22.05.2018. Those candidates who have qualified in the Engineering Entrance Examination were directed to submit the marks obtained for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology in the Second year of Plus Two or equivalent Qualifying Examination through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in for the preparation of Engineering Rank list. Out of **58,268** candidates qualified in the Engineering Entrance Examination, **46,686** candidates have submitted their marks in the second year of the Qualifying Examination to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

For the preparation of Engineering Rank list, equal weightage was given to the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination for Engineering (Paper I & Paper II put together) and the grade/marks obtained for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology put together in the Second year of the Qualifying Examination (Plus Two or equivalent), after effecting the standardization procedure as described in Clause 9.7.4 (b)(iii) of the Prospectus for KEAM 2018.

Some of the Boards/Authorities did not provide the statistical parameters/data essential for the process of standardization of marks of those candidates who studied for the Qualifying Examination under that stream. The marks of candidates from such Boards have been standardized based on the criteria decided upon by the Committee constituted vide G.O.(Rt)No.1061/2017/H.Edn dated 07.06.2017 and the decision is final and binding on the applicant.

Marks obtained by the candidate in the Engineering Entrance Examination (Paper I & Paper II put together) is computed out of 300 and added to the total standardized marks of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology as the case may be in the final year of the Qualifying Examination computed out of 300, both corrected to 4 places of decimals. The rank list for Engineering Courses is then prepared based on the total marks obtained out of 600, computed as above.

The rank list for admission to Architecture (B.Arch) course has been prepared by giving equal weightage to the score obtained in the National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) conducted by the Council of Architecture and to the marks/grades obtained in Qualifying Examination by the candidates as envisaged in clause 9.7.4 (c) of the Prospectus.

The rank list for admission to Pharmacy (B.Pharm) course has been prepared on the basis of the index marks calculated as per clause 9.7.4(f) of the Prospectus for KEAM 2018 based on the marks obtained by a candidate in Paper I (Physics & Chemistry) of the Engineering Entrance Examination.

The rank list for Medical courses except Ayurveda (MBBS, BDS, BHMS, BSMS and BUMS) has been prepared on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG)-2018, subject to the Qualifying criteria as per the Information Bulletin of NEET (UG) 2018 and as per the directions issued by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. Accordingly, in order to qualify and to be included in the rank list for admission to Under Graduate Medical courses (MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BUMS, BSMS and BHMS), a candidate has to secure a minimum of 50th percentile in NEET (UG). However, in respect of SC/ST/SEBC category, the minimum marks shall be 40th percentile. In respect of Persons with Disabilities, the minimum marks shall be 45th percentile for Unreserved category and 40th percentile for SC/ST/SEBC category.

The rank list for Ayurveda (BAMS) course has been prepared on the basis of score obtained in NEET (UG)-2018, subject to satisfying the Qualifying criteria as per the directions issued by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India and as per clause 9.7.4 (e) of the Prospectus.

The rank list for Medical Allied courses (B.Sc (Hons) Agriculture, B.Sc (Hons) Forestry, BVSc & AH and BFSc) has been prepared on the basis of rank obtained in NEET (UG)-2018, subject to the Qualifying criteria as per clause 9.7.5(iii) of the Prospectus.

The results of some of the candidates in the above Rank lists have been withheld due to the defects in their application or due to other reasons. The results of such candidates will be released as and when the reasons for withholding their results are cleared.

The inclusion of a candidate in the rank list does not entitle him/her for admission to the courses unless he/she satisfies all the conditions of eligibility as prescribed in the Prospectus. Candidates will be admitted to the courses only if the academic eligibility conditions as prescribed in the Prospectus under Clause 6.2 are fulfilled at the time of admission. This will be verified by the college authorities concerned, at the time of admission. The marks in the Qualifying Examination reckoned for preparing the Engineering rank list will be final and will be subjected to verification by the admitting authority. In case any discrepancy is noticed by the admitting authority in the marks submitted for the preparation of Engineering rank list, the candidature will be cancelled.

The category/community-wise lists based on the rank lists will be published in due course.
