MOP-UP COUNSELLING TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES (EXCEPT MBBS, BDS)
ONLINE OPTIONS REGISTRATION- INVITED.

The Online Option registration for the Mop-up Counselling to Medical & Allied Courses (Except M.B.B.S, BDS) has commenced on **29.08.2019** to fill up the remaining vacant seats. In this phase allotment will be done to other Medical course such as Ayurveda (BAMS), Homoeopathy (BHMS) Sidha, Unani and Allied course such as Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses.

All the Candidates included in the Kerala medical, Ayurveda rank lists can register Options unless otherwise stated. Candidates who want to be considered for the allotment to Medical & Allied Courses (Except M.B.B.S/BDS) shall have to log into their Home page provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. by clicking 'Option Registration' button available there in from 29.08.2019, 6.00 pm onwards. Candidates can register fresh options from 29.08.2019 to 01.09.2019, 05.00 pm through the above website. The allotment on the basis of options received within the stipulated time will be published on **02.09.2019**. Candidates who receive allotment shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/ balance fee payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, at any of the **Head Post Offices in Kerala** or by way of **Online Payment** on any date from **03.09.2019** to **06.09.2019, 3.00 pm**. The list of Post offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website.

Candidates who stand admitted in Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani courses under All India Quota and MBBS, BDS courses as per the State allotment shall not be considered for the Mop-Up Counselling. Also Candidates who get admission till 31.08.2019 for MBBS, BDS courses will not be considered in this Online Mop-Up Counselling. If the Candidate who has already been admitted to Ayurveda, Homoeo, Sidha, Unani, Agriculture, Forestry, Veterinary and Fisheries courses gets allotment in new colleges through Mop-Up counselling as per option, his/her previous admission will be cancelled.

<p align="center">03.09.2019 to 06.09.2019, 3.00 pm</p>	<p>Candidates who receive allotment should remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to CEE in any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment and should report before the college authorities to join the allotted college/course .</p>
<p align="center">06.09.2019, 05.00 pm</p>	<p>All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS)</p>

Candidates who do not register their online options are not considered for the Mop-up counselling.

Note:

- 1) Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
- 2) The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they upload the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before 12.00 noon on 01.09.2019

Important

Candidates who are admitted in Engineering/Architecture/Pharmacy courses at present, if allotted to other Medical & Allied courses in this phase can accept the new allotment by satisfying the condition of clause 12.2.3, 12.2.4 of the Prospectus for KEAM 2019.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have no token deposit.
