SPOT ALLOTMENT TO SIDDHA COURSE (BSMS) -2019

As per the Government Order G.O.(Rt)No.517/2019/AYUSH, Dated. 09.10.2019 from Ayush (A) Department permission has been given to conduct spot allotment to the 25 vacant seats in Siddha Course in Santhigiri Siddha Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. The spot allotment will start at 11.00 am on 14.10.2019 at the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, 5th floor, Housing Board Building, Santhi Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram. The Candidates who are included in the Kerala State medical Rank list published by the CEE can participate in the Spot allotment. In the absence of such candidates, the vacancy is to be filled from the candidates who secured required percentile score in NEET, irrespective of their domicile.

Documents to be submitted at the time of Spot Allotment:

- 1) Demand Draft for the requisite amount , original documents of the candidate including Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate and Original mark list(s) of the qualifying examination (Higher Secondary or equivalent) along with the Pass certificate of the qualifying examination (if issued).
- 2) Eligibility certificate from any University in Kerala, in the case of candidates who have passed a qualifying examination other than Higher Secondary Examination/Vocational Higher Secondary Examination conducted by Government of Kerala or the examination conducted by CBSE and CISCE.
- 3) Migration Certificate, if applicable.
- 4) Certificate to prove date of birth.
- 5) Data sheet of KEAM 2019 (Candidates included in the Kerala State Medical Rank List).
- 6) NEET Score Sheet-2019
- 7) Physical Fitness Certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure XVII (b) of the Prospectus 2019.

Fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations	Rs.1,00,000/- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O. (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O. (MS) 10/2014/BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014, have no token deposit.(Candidates included as per the list published by CEE)

Way of Remittance	Candidates getting allotment during the spot allotment shall have to remit the fee as given above at the venue of spot allotment by way of Demand Draft drawn from a Nationalized Bank in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram.
Academic eligibility	BSMS: Candidates who have passed in the subjects Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology in the Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognised equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Biotechnology separately, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology put together, are eligible. In the absence of Biology, Biotechnology will be considered as a subject for academic eligibility.
