Centralised Allotment Process for Admission to LL.M Course 2014 -15

The Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) for allotment and Admission to LL.M Course- in four Government Law Colleges and two Self Financing Law colleges of the State for the year 2014-15 will be conducted in the office of the commissioner for Entrance Examinations, 5th floor, Housing Board Buildings, Santhi Nagar, Thiruvananthapuram on 1st February 2015. Candidates or their authorised representative (with authorisation letter as given in Annexure 1 of the Prospectus) should report at the allotment venue strictly as per the time schedule. They should produce the Admit Card of the Entrance Examination, proof of Date of Birth, all original documents to prove Academic Eligibility etc as per Clause 16 (11) of the prospectus, at the time of allotment. Individual memos will not be sent to the candidates in connection with the Centralised Allotment Process.
