NOTIFICATION

Entrance Examination for Admission to LL.M Course 2017-18

1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination for admission to LL.M Course 2017-18 in Government Law Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Kozhikode and in private Self Financing Law Colleges of Kerala which have entered into Seat sharing agreement with the State Government.
2. **Eligibility for Admission**
 - (i) **Nativity:** Applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala Origin. [See clause 5 of the Prospectus]
 - (ii) **Academic qualifications:** Candidates who have passed the L.L.B. examination (5 year / 3 year course) with a minimum of 50% marks from the Universities in Kerala or other Universities recognised by the Universities in Kerala as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission. Candidates appearing / appeared for the regular Final year LL.B. examination can also apply for the Entrance Examination. Such candidates become eligible for admission only if they produce the Provisional / Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination and the mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
 - (iii) **Age:** There is no upper age limit for admission to the LL. M Course.
3. **Entrance Examination:** The Entrance Examination will be conducted at Thiruvananthapuram, on 25.02.2018 (Sunday). There will be two papers each of 90 minutes duration, from 9.30am to 11.00am (Paper-I) and 11.30 am to 1.00pm (Paper-II). Each paper will consist of 100 Objective Type questions. The questions will be of the standard of LL.B Examination.
4. **Submission of Online Application and Application Fee:** The application fee is Rs. 800/- (Rupees eight hundred only) for General and SEBC candidates and Rs. 400/- (Rupees four hundred only) for SC/ST candidates. Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from 27.01.2018 to 07.02.2018, 5pm and then remit the required application fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application (see clause 11.2.3). They can use Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card for online payment. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post Offices in Kerala. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. After remitting the fee the candidate has to upload a recent passport size colour photograph, signature and required documents/certificates as mentioned in clause 11.2.4 of the prospectus along with the online application. No need to send the printout of the application to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Certificates/Documents to be uploaded in the Online Application

- Nativity Proof: Any one of the documents mentioned under clause 5.
 - Certificate to prove age: Relevant page of SSLC/Birth Certificate/Passport
 - Certificates obtained from Tahsildar in the case of SC/ST candidates.
 - Non-Creamy Layer Certificate in the prescribed format from the Village Officer concerned in the case of SEBC/OEC candidates.
 - Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned in the case of OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy layer category.
 - Non-Creamy Layer/Community and Income Certificates from the Village officer concerned in the prescribed format in the case of candidates belonging to the communities listed in Annexure IV (a).
 - Inter-Caste marriage certificate: Candidates who are children of Inter-Caste married couple of whom one is SC/ST, need to upload Inter-Caste marriage Certificate issued by Tahsildar.
 - Attested copy of Certificate from the District Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities (if applicable).
 - Certificate from the Fisheries Officer concerned of Kerala Fishermen Welfare Fund Board for fee concession in the case of candidates who are the children of registered Fishermen.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to include any additional information in the application form or to submit any certificate / document claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application, under any circumstances.
6. Certificates submitted should be in the prescribed format available along with the printout of the application.
7. The candidates registered for the examination can download their **ADMIT CARDS** from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 17.02.2018 onwards. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall.
8. **Allotment of Seats:** The institution-wise allotment will be made by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with the rank obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Examination and the order of preference of institutions registered by the candidates during Online Centralised Allotment Process (CAP). The date for CAP will be notified on the website and in leading newspapers. Individual intimation in this regard will not be sent to candidates.
9. The Entrance Examination and subsequent allotments will be based on the provisions laid down in the Prospectus for Admission to LL.M Course, Kerala 2017-18, available in the website www.cee-kerala.org. Candidates are advised to read the Prospectus before submitting their applications.
