ALLOTMENT TO LL.M COURSE 2017-18
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Centralised Allotment Process for admission to LL.M Course in four Government Law Colleges and the Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2017-18 will commence on **15.03.2018**. The rank list and category list of the Entrance Examination for admission to LL.M course 2017 conducted on 11.03.2018 will be published before 20th March 2018. The Centralized Allotment will be based on the above rank list and category list.

Candidates can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **15.03.2018** to **20.03.2018, 3 pm**. Candidate may enter their Application Number & Password in the link '**LL.M 2017-Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item '**Option Registration**' candidates can register their options online. The first allotment based on the online options received upto 3 pm on 20.03.2018 and the rank list and category list of LL.M 2017 Entrance Examination, will be published on **21.03.2018**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges on any date from 22.03.2018 to 24.03.2018, 3 pm. Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

Data Sheet: By clicking the menu item '**Data Sheet**', candidates can download their Data Sheet. The Data Sheet thus obtained will have to be produced at the time of admission in the colleges.

The required fee for the LL.M Courses should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clauses 4 & 5** of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of Admission

1. Candidate's Data Sheet.
2. Allotment Memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
3. Original Mark list of LL.B. examinations (All Mark Lists)
4. Provisional/Degree Certificate
5. Any other documents mentioned in the Allotment Memo
6. Transfer certificate
7. Conduct certificate from the Head of the institution where the candidate studied last or from a Gazetted Officer, obtained within the last six months
8. Four copies of passport size photograph of the candidate
9. Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce "Eligibility Certificate/Equivalency Certificate" from a University in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognized by the University.
10. Applicant who is employed or a trainee in Government service, Scheduled Bank etc. should produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the office where the applicant is employed at the time of interview.
11. Originals of all the documents/certificates uploaded along with the online application (to prove nativity /reservation/fee concession).

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims, if any, in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Spot Allotment: The vacant seats, if any, remaining after 5 pm on 24.03.2018 shall be filled up through Spot Allotment/Admission to be conducted by the college authorities concerned on or before **31st March 2018**, strictly in accordance with the stipulations in clause 18 of the Prospectus for admission to LL.M Courses 2017-18.

Candidates are advised not to give unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted. All details related to the allotment process are available on the website www.cee-kerala.org.
