



ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE COURSES IN AYURVEDA, KERALA 2017-18

NOTIFICATION

1. Applications are invited for the admission to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda for the year 2017-18 in Government Ayurveda Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Trippunithura and Kannur, Aided Ayurveda Colleges at Ollur and Kottakkal and other Self Financing colleges in the following specialties.

2. **Eligibility for admission:**

i) **Nativity :** Applicant should be an Indian Citizen.

ii) **Age:** Candidate should not be over 45 years of age as on 31.07.2017, subject to a relaxation of five years in the case of SC/ST candidates. The upper age limit of Service candidates is 50 years as on 31.07.2017.

iii) **Academic Qualifications:** Candidates should have obtained BAM /Ayurvedacharya /BAMS from the colleges having CCIM recognition and BAMS Degree of Universities in Kerala or its equivalent degree recognized by the University of Kerala with 50% of marks for theory and practical separately in each subject. But exemption for minimum marks prescribed for admission for MD (Ay)/MS (Ay) is granted to the students who have passed the BAMS/BAM examination before 1995 from the Universities of Kerala without 50% of marks for theory and practical. **Applicants who had completed compulsory internship on or before 31.08.2017 are eligible to apply for admission subject to the production of Internship Certificate from the Medical Council constituted in this regard.**

3. **Mode of selection:** Selection of candidates including the seats reserved for Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M and for the candidate sponsored by the Lakshadweep Administration will be made on the basis of the rank obtained in Entrance Examination conducted by the All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA).

4. **Submission of Applications and Application Fee:** All candidates including Service Candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda (MD Ayurveda) can apply in the Online application form available from 16/10/2017 provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at, Head/Sub post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee upload photo and signature of the candidates and all necessary certificates /Documents, Mark Sheet-Cum-Result Certificate of AIAPGET-2017.

Service Candidates (Medical Officer of the Department of I.S.M) should sent their Application by taking printout of the online application affixing passport size photograph (same Photo uploaded in AIAPGET-2017) attested by a Gazetted Officer along with NOC

(No Objection Certificate) and all necessary Certificates to the Director, Directorate of Ayurveda Medical Education, Arogyabhavan, MG Road, Thiruvananthapuram.

No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Application Fee for General Candidates and Service Candidates is Rs.1000/- In case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms)No.25/05/SC/ST DD dated 22.03.2005 is Rs.500/-. Service Candidates seeking admission in General Quota also should pay an extra amount of Rs.1000/-. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 15/10/2017 onwards.

5. **Last date and time for online submission of application:** All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in clause 9.2.4 of the prospectus before 5 pm of 19/10/2017. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard
6. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/Documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application.
7. Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to MD Ayurveda courses 2017 available on the Official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee-kerala.org before filling up the Online application forms.
