### **ADMISSION TO P G DENTAL COURSES, KERALA-2018** **First phase of Allotment Published**

The First phase allotment to the P G Dental Courses 2018 in Government Dental Colleges and Self-financing Dental Colleges is published herewith. This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published on 10/04/2018 and the online options filed by the candidates from 05/04/2018 to 11/04/2018, 3 pm. The Candidates eligible for NRI quota is also published. The allotment result and NRI list are available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

To view the allotment result, candidates should logon to the 'PG Dental -2018 Candidate Portal' by submitting their respective Application Number and Password. Clicking on the menu 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result page. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment Memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the first phase allotment memo to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in order to accept the allotment. This fee can be remitted by using the **Online Payment Facility from 16/04/2018 to 21/04/2018**. The date of joining in Colleges by the allotted candidates will be 16/04/2018 to 21/04/2018 before 5pm. The candidates who get an allotment should take admission in the respective Dental colleges before 5 p.m. on 21/04/2018 along with the documents specified in the Allotment Memo . The allotted Candidates who do not take admission in the respective College before the time specified will lose his/her present allotment as well as all the higher options. All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at 5 p.m. on 21/04/2018.
