## NOTIFICATION

### ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL (MDS) COURSES, KERALA-2018 SPOT ADMISSION TO VACANT SEATS

A Spot Admission to fill up the vacant seats in P G Dental (MDS) Courses - 2018 in Government/Self Financing Dental colleges will be conducted at 9.30 am on **29.05.2018** at the **C.O Karunakaran Auditorium** inside the **Government Medical College campus, Thiruvananthapuram.**

Candidates included in the “**Kerala State Rank list**” alone will be eligible for participating in the Spot Admission process. All candidates in the said rank list can download a **Spot Admission Slip** from the above portal. The Spot Admission Slip is mandatory for a candidate to participate in the Spot Admission process.

#### Guidelines for Spot Admission

1. The spot admission will be based on the Kerala State Rank list.
2. The spot admission will be manual and as per the provisions contained in clause 11(XIX) of the Prospectus for admission to PG Dental Courses (MDS) 2018. A candidate who figures in the Kerala State Rank list prepared for Admission to PG Dental (MDS) Courses-2018 can attend the Spot Admission. Those who are holding All India Quota seats will not be entitled to attend the Spot admission process.
3. Candidates who have obtained admission in Government merit seats for a subject in any of the Government Dental Colleges shall not be eligible to participate in the Spot Admission for the same subject in other Government Dental colleges. Similarly candidates who have obtained admission in a course in any of the Self Financing colleges shall not be eligible to participate in the Spot Admission for the same subject in other Self Financing Dental colleges. However, a candidate who got admission in a Self Financing Dental College shall be permitted to take admission in the same/different subject in a Government Dental College through Spot Admission and vice-versa.
4. Transfer from the NRI quota seats to Management or General Quota seats and vice versa are permitted.
5. Candidates (except SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen) getting fresh admission to any Government Dental college through spot allotment shall have to produce a **Demand Draft for Rs. 45,000/- (Forty five thousand) drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram** at the time of allotment. Candidates getting fresh allotment in Private Self Financing College shall have to bring a **Demand Draft for Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five lakhs) drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram.** Remaining fee shall have to be remitted in the allotted college.

6. For SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen candidate allotted to a Government Dental College or Government seats in Private Self Financing Colleges the token amount of Rs.1000(Thousand only) to be paid as Demand Draft at the venue of allotment. SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen candidates allotted to a seat in Management, NRI/ Minority Community seats in Private Self Financing Dental College shall have to pay the fees fixed for that seat.
7. A candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the first or second round of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this spot admission.
8. All vacant seats reported by the colleges concerned/DME at 5.30 pm on 25.05.2018 due to non-joining / issue of TC will be included at the spot admission scheduled to be conducted on 29.05.2018. Course once allotted in the spot admission shall be final. Mere surrender/Exchange of seat in the Spot Allotment/Admission will not be allowed.
9. The vacancies created at the time of spot admission will be filled up then and there itself according to merit and eligibility

**Documents in original to be produced at the time of Spot Admission**

1. Admit card of PG Dental (MDS) Entrance Examination-2018 issued by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi
2. Originals of all the Uploaded documents
3. Document to prove date of birth.
4. Pass/Degree certificate of the qualifying examination (BDS Degree).
5. Permanent Registration Certificate from Kerala Dental Council & up-to-date Renewal certificate
6. CRRRI Certificate.
7. Certificate of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate from KUHS for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination (BDS Degree) from Universities outside Kerala.
8. Spot Admission Slip.
9. Demand Draft for token amount/Tuition fee to be paid to CEE.
10. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate
11. Any other documents mentioned in the allotment notification.


- NOTE:**
1. A candidate who is holding any seat allotted by CEE need to submit the Spot Admission Slip only.
  2. The vacant seats in Government/ Private Self Financing Dental Colleges after the second round of counseling will be published before the spot 29/05/2018.

Representatives of all colleges who are competent to issue Transfer Certificate, if necessary are directed to be present at the venue of Spot allotment/admission at 9.30 am on 29-05-2018 without fail. They are also directed to bring all the original documents collected from the students at the time of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> phases of allotment.

**Important:**

- a) The candidates who are allotted with a seat in the spot admission and who discontinues the course on any reason after this admission shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as per Clause 13-2 of the prospectus for admission to PG Dental Courses 2018.
