## NOTIFICATION

### ALLOTMENT/ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL COURSES-2019-20 Re-opening of application submission facility in view of lowering of the minimum qualifying percentile

The NEET-MDS-2019 minimum qualifying percentiles has been lowered by the National Board of Examinations as per the Letter no. V.12025/82/2018/-DE dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019, MoHFW as shown in the table below. Hence the online application submission facility for admission to MDS-2019 course in Government and Self-financing Dental Colleges in Kerala will be re-opened from 10/04/2019 to 15/04/2019, 3 pm. In online application submission, those candidates who are newly qualified as per the revised qualification only can submit applications. ie, those general candidates with percentile not lower than 25.835<sup>th</sup> and lower than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile, those SC/ST/OBC/SC-PD/ST-PD/OBC-PD candidates with percentile not lower than 15.835<sup>th</sup> and lower than 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and those general PD candidates with percentile not lower than 20.835<sup>th</sup> and lower than 45<sup>th</sup> percentile can only submit applications. Similarly those candidates who claim for any community category with percentile higher than 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile and those candidates who claim for PD category with percentile higher than 45<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than 50<sup>th</sup> percentile will be considered only as general candidates. Candidates can avail this facility through the link 'PG Dental 2019 - Re-Opening Online Application' and should complete the online submission of application and upload the required documents within the deadline. Those candidates who wish to apply in Community/Minority quota seats in self-financing dental Colleges should also upload the certificates from the village officer concerned. The application facility is hosted in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). Newly qualified candidates, who find a place in the rank list, can participate in the remaining phases of allotment process subject to the condition that none of the allotments/admission carried out in the previous phase allotment is disturbed.
