### **ADMISSION TO P G DENTAL COURSES, KERALA-2020** **Second phase of Allotment published**

The Second phase allotment to the P G Dental Courses for the year 2020 in Government Dental Colleges and Self-financing Dental Colleges is published herewith. This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list & Category List and on the online options filed by the candidates from **02/07/2020 to 07/07/2020, 10 am**. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

A total of 10 All India Quota seats have been surrendered to State Quota seat. The seat distribution of surrendered seats has been published in the above website.

To view the allotment result, candidates should logon to the '**PG Dental -2020 Candidate Portal**' by submitting their respective **Application Number and Password**. Clicking on the menu '**Allotment Result**', candidates can view their allotment result page. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment Memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the Allotment Memo to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in order to accept the allotment. Those candidates who receive fresh allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the second phase allotment memo to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment or in any designated Head Post Office, by way of e -chalan, in order to accept the allotment. Candidates who receive a change in allotment than the previous allotment shall have to remit the balance fee, if any, to be remitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as above.

After remitting the required fee/balance fee, the allotted candidates should report physically for joining the allotted colleges before **4 pm on 16.07.2020**, along with the required documents specified in the allotment memo. The balance tuition fee, if any, to be remitted to the college should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective college before the time specified will lose his/her allotment as well as all the higher options. All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5 pm on 16.07.2020**.
