**ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSES
IN HOMOEOPATHY (MD HOMOEOPATHY), KERALA 2017-18**

1. Applications are invited from the candidates who have passed the BHMS (Direct/Graded) Degree or its equivalent declared thereto by the Central Council of Homoeopathy for admission to MD Homoeopathy Courses for the year 2017-18 in the Government Homoeopathic Medical Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode.
2. **Eligibility for Admission:**
 - a) **Nativity:** Applicant should be an Indian Citizen.
 - b) **Academic Eligibility:** Candidates who have passed the BHMS Degree (Direct/Graded) or its equivalent, declared there to, by the Central Council of Homoeopathy. Candidates who have completed the prescribed internship before the date of interview for allotment alone are eligible for admission subject to the condition that they should produce the Medical Council Registration Certificate at the time of interview for allotment. Candidates who have passed the final year examination with more than three chances are not eligible for admission
 - c) **Age:** The candidates otherwise eligible for admission should not be more than 45 years as on the first day of January of this year subject to relaxation to a maximum of five years in the case of SC/ST and to Teachers of Homoeopathic Medical Colleges.
3. **Mode of Selection:** The Selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of the Qualifying marks in All India level common Entrance test namely AYUSH National Post Graduate Entrance Test.
4. **Submission of Applications and Application Fee:** All candidates including Service Candidates seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree Courses in Homoeopathy (MD Homoeo) can apply in the Online application form available from 16/10/2017 provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at, Head/Sub post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee upload photo and signature of the candidates and all necessary certificates /Documents, Mark Sheet-Cum-Result Certificate of AIAPGET-2017.
Service quota candidates including Rural Service should send their Application by taking printout of the online application affixing passport size photograph (same Photo uploaded in AIAPGET-2017) attested by a Gazetted Officer along with NOC (No Objection Certificate) and all necessary Certificates to the Principal and Controlling Officer, Government Homoeopathic Medical College, Iranimuttom, Thiruvananthapuram, Pin 695009. Rural Service Candidate should produce Service Certificate from the Director of Homoeopathy along with application.
No need to send the printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
Application Fee for General Candidates and Service Candidates is Rs.900/- (Rupees Nine hundred only) In case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms)No.25/05/SC/ST DD dated 22.03.2005 is Rs.450/- (Rupees four hundred and fifty only). Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in
5. **Last date and time for online submission of application:** All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in clause 6.3.6 of the prospectus before 5 pm of 19/10/2017. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard
6. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/Documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application.
7. Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to PG Homoeo courses 2017 available on the Official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee-kerala.org before filling up the Online application forms.
