ADMISSION TO P G MEDICAL (DEGREE / DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA-2016 Second phase of Allotment and Procedure for Spot Admission

The Second phase allotment to the P G Medical (Degree/Diploma) Courses 2016 in Government Medical Colleges, including the seats reverted from All India Quota and Government Seats in Govt. Controlled/Private Self Financing Medical Colleges are published herewith. This allotment is based on the rank and online options filed by the candidates from 13.05.2016 to 19.05.2016, 5 pm. The allotment list is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

To view the allotment result, candidates should logon to the 'PGM 2016 - Candidate Portal' by submitting their respective Application Number and Roll number. Clicking on the tab 'Allotment Result' followed by entering the password and key number will take the candidate to the allotment result page. It's necessary to take a printout of the Allotment Memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fee/ balance fee to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the second phase allotment memo. This fee can be remitted using the **Online Payment Facility** or at any of the **designated branches of State Bank of Travancore** from 21.05.2016 to 25.05.2016. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website.

The candidates who get an allotment should take admission in the respective Medical colleges before 5 p.m. on 25.05.2016(Wednesday) along with the documents specified in the Allotment Memo as per the GO(Rt) No. 1425/2016/H&FWD dated: 20.05.2016. All the college authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at 5.30 p.m. on 25.05.2016.

SPOT ADMISSION:

The spot admission to fill up the vacant State Quota seats in Government/Government Controlled Self Financing/Private Self Financing Medical colleges including Service Quota seats after the second round of counseling for admission to P G Medical courses - 2016 will be conducted on 27.05.2016(Friday) at the **Old Auditorium inside the Medical College campus, Thiruvananthapuram** as per G.O(Rt).No.1425/2016/H&FWD dated 20.05.2016 .The spot admission will be manual and as per the provisions contained in clause 11-1.18 of the prospectus for admission to PG Medical courses 2016. A candidate who figures in the Rank list/Category lists prepared as per clause 10 of the Prospectus for Admission to Medical PG Degree/Diploma Courses-2016-17 but not joined under All India Quota seats alone is entitled to attend the Spot allotment/admission process. Candidates who have obtained admission in Government merit seats for a course in any of the Government Medical colleges shall not be eligible to participate in the Spot Allotment/Admission for the same subject in other Government Medical colleges. Similarly candidates who have obtained admission in Government merit seats for a course in any of the Self Financing Medical colleges shall not be eligible to participate in the Spot Allotment/Admission for the same subject in other Self Financing Medical colleges. However a candidate who got admission in Government merit seat

of a Self Financing Medical College shall be permitted to take admission in the same/other subject in a Government Medical College through Spot Allotment/Admission. All vacant seats reported by the colleges concerned/DME on or before 5.30 pm on 25.05.2016 due to non-joining/issue of TC will be included at the spot admission scheduled to be conducted on 27.05.2016. Course once allotted in the spot admission shall be final. Mere surrender/Exchange of seat in the Spot Allotment/Admission will not be allowed.

The spot admission to the General Quota seats will be based on the Rank list and Category list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The counseling to the Service Quota seats will be based on the Rank list of Insurance Medical Service Quota (IMSQ) and the Rank lists of Health Service Quota (HSQ) and Medical Education Service Quota (MESQ) published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The service candidates are directed to report at the venue of the spot admission at 9.30 am on 27.05.2016. The General Quota candidates are directed to report at the venue of the spot admission at 11.00 am on 27.05.2016. The candidates appearing for the spot admission shall produce all their original certificates to prove their academic eligibility along with the Admit Card issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. However a candidate who is holding any seat allotted during the first or second round of counseling conducted by the CEE need to submit the Admit Card issued by the CEE and the possession certificate from the concerned Principal of the allotted college that the candidate's original certificates are kept in the custody of the College authority. The vacancies created at the time of spot admission will be filled up then and there itself according to merit and eligibility.

The candidates who get allotment will be issued with an allotment memo and the fee to be paid will be shown in the memo. The candidates who get an allotment in the Government Medical Colleges should pay the fees shown in the allotment memo at the venue of allotment itself (General Candidates- Rs 50,000/- for P G Degree Courses and Rs. 45000/- for P G Diploma Courses; SC/ST/OEC candidates-Rs.1000/-). In the case of candidates allotted to a Government Controlled Self Financing Medical College/ Private Self Financing Medical Colleges, a general category candidate should pay an amount of Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) at the venue of spot admission itself, as token of having accepted the admission. The balance amount of fees should be paid at the college concerned. For an SC/ST/OEC candidate allotted to a Government Controlled Self Financing Medical College/ Private Self Financing Medical Colleges, the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only). However a candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the first or second round of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this spot admission. SC/ST/OEC candidates admitted under Service Quota are not eligible for any exemption of fees as per clause 7 of the Prospectus.

Important: The candidates who are allotted with a subject in the spot admission and who discontinues the course on any reason after this admission shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as per Clause 13-2 of the prospectus.
