### **ADMISSION TO P G MEDICAL (DEGREE/DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA-2019** **MOP-UP COUNSELING TO FILL UP VACANT SEATS**

A Mop-Up Counseling to fill up the vacant seats in P G Medical courses - 2019 in Government/Self Financing Medical colleges will be conducted at **9.30 am** on **06/05/2019** at **Thiruvananthapuram**. The venue of Mop-Up counseling will be announced later. The Mop-up counseling will be conducted as per the guidelines issued vide G.O.(Rt)No.968/2019/H&FWD dated: 24.04.2019.

Eligible candidates included in the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register for Mop-Up counselling through the link '**PG Medical 2019: Candidate Portal**' provided in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) and download a **Mop-Up Registration Slip** from the above portal. The facility to register for Mop-Up round and to download Mop-Up registration slip will be available in the above website from **04.05.2019 to 8 pm on 05.05.2019**. The Mop-Up Registration Slip is mandatory for a candidate to participate in the Mop-Up Round Counseling process.

#### **Guidelines for Mop-Up Round Counseling**

- 1) The Mop-Up Round will be based on the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 2) Course once allotted in the Mop-Up round shall be final. Mere surrender/exchange of seats in the Mop-Up round will not be allowed. Surrender of seats after allotment in the Mop-Up round will also be not permitted.
- 3) The DGHS, New Delhi has furnished a list of candidates who stand admitted under All India Quota/Central Universities/Deemed Universities. These candidates are also not eligible to participate in the Mop-Up Round.
- 4) The Candidates who stand joined PG Course in State quota in Second Phase Allotment shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop-Up Round. Candidates already holding a PG seat can participate in the Mop-Up Counselling only after surrender of seat held by them by cancelling their admission at the college, **before 5 pm on 03.05.2019**. The exit shall be allowed on forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee.
- 5) The candidates who have been allotted PG Course in State quota on exit, after being allotted to the seats in the second round will have to forfeit 10% of the annual fee if they do not join the course ie., the exit shall be allowed on forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee during the second round and if they have joined the course they will not be eligible for further counseling. In case the applicant retains the seats in the first allotment and he/she is not allotted any seats in the second allotment then this allotment in the first allotment will be considered as equivalent to the seat allotted in second round and he will have to forfeit 10% of annual fee, if he decides to quit before the last date of surrender of seat already allotted. **The last date and time for surrender of seat is 03/05/2019, 5pm.**
- 6) Candidates (except SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home) getting fresh admission to any Government Medical college through Mop-Up Round shall have to produce a Demand Draft for **Rs. 50,000/- for Degree Courses** and **Rs. 45,000/- for Diploma Courses** drawn in favour of **Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram** at the

time of allotment. However, a candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the first or second round of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this Mop-Up Round Counseling.

- 7) A candidate getting fresh allotment in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges for Degree/Diploma Courses shall have to remit Rs. 5,00,000/- by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram. Remaining fees shall have to be remitted in the allotted college.
- 8) For an SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidate allotted to a Government Medical College or Government seats in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges (Except Management, NRI/ Minority Community seats), the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram.
- 9) Those candidates including SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home who are allotted but not joined in a course in the Second Phase of Allotment can participate in the Mop-Up round by forfeiting an amount equal to 10% of annual fee of the College/Course allotted in the second phase. Exit fee can be paid by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and the original Demand Draft should be produced at the Mop-up counseling venue.
- 10) SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidates are not exempted from remittance of Exit Fee and the Exit Fee for such candidates will be at par with that of General candidates.
- 11) SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidates allotted to a seat in Management, NRI/Minority community quota in Private Self Financing Medical college shall have to pay the fees fixed for that seat.

**Documents to be produced at the time of Mop-Up Round Counseling**

1. Mop-Up Registration slip
2. NEET-PG 2019 score sheet
3. Originals of all the documents uploaded at the time of submission of application.
4. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate.
5. Admit card issued by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi
6. Document to prove date of birth
7. Pass/Degree certificate in the qualifying examination (MBBS Degree).
8. Permanent Registration Certificate from the T.C Medical Council.
9. CRRI Certificate.
10. Certificate of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate from KUHS for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination (MBBS Degree) from outside Kerala.
11. Demand Draft for Tuition Fee/Token amount to be paid to CEE.
12. Demand Draft for exit fee, if applicable.

**NOTE:** The candidates who are allotted with a seat in the Mop-Up Round and who discontinues the course on any reason after the Mop-Up Counselling shall be liable to pay Rs.50 lakhs as liquidated damages as per Clause 12-2 of the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses - 2019.
