**SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO
POST GRADUATE MEDICAL (DEGREE/DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA - 2019
FACILITY FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION/REGISTRATION/DELETION/REARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE**

The activities related to the second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2019 in the State commences on **22/04/2019**. The vacant seats expected to be reverted from All India Quota, the vacant seats under State quota after the first round of counseling in Government Medical Colleges, Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram and Self-financing Medical Colleges including NRI and Minority Community quota seats and the newly included seats shall be filled up in this phase of allotment.

Candidates included in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log on to the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and then click the link '**P G Medical 2019-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can then re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options and also register fresh options to the newly included courses after clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also re-arrange/delete their existing options and also register fresh options to the newly included courses. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement/registration shall be available in the above website from **22/04/2019 to 26/04/2019, 9 am**. Those who are holding All India Quota seats as per the list furnished by MCC/DGHS are not eligible to participate in this phase of allotment.

Online Option confirmation is mandatory

The candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and joined in the course/college allotted and also the candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment shall have to confirm their options online by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in the Home page of the candidate. Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase of allotment for the existing options.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

22.04.2019	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, re-arrangement/ deletion of existing higher options and for registration of fresh options
26.04.2019, 9 am	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion/ registration of options ends.
26.04.2019, 8 pm	Publication of second phase allotment
27.04.2019 to 03/05/2019	All candidates who get an allotment should remit the fee / balance fee* to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of Post Office or by way of Online Payment and should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt.
03/05/2019, 5pm	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee/balance fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college/course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

*** The fees in respect of Self Financing Medical Colleges is purely provisional and subject to changes. Candidates shall have to execute an undertaking to the respective institutions on a Bond paper of Rs. 200/- in Annexure III to G.O (Rt) No. 798/2019/H&FWD dated: 28.03.2019 stating that the difference in fee, if any, as per the decision of the Committee to be constituted under the Ordinance shall be paid by them within one month.**

Note: Candidates who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home, Juvenile home are exempted from payment of fees. However, they have to pay an amount of Rs.1000/- as token of having accepted the allotment.
