ADMISSION TO THE VACANT SEATS IN P G MEDICAL COURSES, KERALA - 2019

Revised Rank list After Including the Newly Qualified Candidates Published

The Central Government in consultation with the Medical Council of India has reduced the cut-off percentile for qualifying in NEET PG 2019 for admissions to P G Medical courses-2019 vide notification dated 08.05.2019. Accordingly, fresh applications were invited from the newly qualified candidates and a revised Kerala State Rank list has been prepared by including the newly qualified candidates also.

The revised Kerala State Rank list is published herewith in the websites www.cee-kerala.org and www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The revised Kerala State rank list has been prepared by considering also the candidates who have newly qualified in the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET PG-2019) conducted by the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi and who satisfy the Nativity conditions as per clause 4.2 of the prospectus for admission to P G Medical Courses 2019.

The revised rank list with number of candidates equaling to ten times the number of vacant seats has been made available to the Medical Colleges in the State. The details of seats remaining vacant after the Mop-Up counseling conducted on 06.05.2019 are available in the above websites. Candidates who wish to get admission to any of the vacant seats can directly approach the Medical College concerned for admission. The last date and time for such admission is **5 pm on 18.05.2019**.

The newly qualified candidates have been included in the rank list provisionally and the category/community as claimed by the newly qualified candidates in the online application has been assigned to these candidates while preparing the rank list. Such candidates shall have to produce all the original records/certificates to prove their various claims/eligibility before the college authorities at the time of admission, failing which, the admission shall not be granted under any circumstances.
