ALLOTMENT TO P G PHARMACY COURSES (M.PHARM), KERALA-2017

SCHEDULE FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Pharmacy Course (M.Pharm.) for the year 2017 will commence from 19-07.2017 (Wednesday).

Rank list was prepared by Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Kerala on the basis of Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) 2017 and subject to other eligibility conditions prescribed in the clause 3 of the Prospectus approved by government. In case of a tie in GPAT score, the candidate who has scored more marks in the qualifying examination (B.Pharm) will be placed higher

The General, Category and Service Quota candidates included in the above Rank list can register their options on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 19-07-2017 to 23.07.2017, 5 PM, after downloading their Data Sheet.

Candidate shall have to click 'MPharm 2017-Candidate Portal' available in the above website. After that the candidates have to enter their Application Number and Password in order to access their home page. They can download their Data Sheet by clicking the menu item 'Data Sheet'. The Data Sheet thus obtained will have to be produced at the time of admission in the colleges.

The Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' available in the home page.

Results of some of the candidates have been withheld due to the defects in their online applications. Such candidates can also register their options online, but they will not be considered for allotment unless they upload the required documents to correct the defects through the above website before 5 pm on 21.07.2017.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

20.07.2017	Opening of the option registration facility.
24.07.2017 - 5 pm	Closing of option registration facility.
25.07.2017	First Allotment
26.07.2017 to 28.04.2017	Payment of Fees and Joining in the colleges
28.04.2017, 5.30 pm	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

The list of Pharmacy Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. **A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted.** Options registered online alone will be considered for allotment to the courses. Options sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via Post/Fax/E-mail will not be processed /considered for allotment to the courses.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

List of Colleges:

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the P G Pharmacy (M Pharm) courses in all seats in Government colleges and government seats in various self financing colleges in the first phase.

Fees:

Colleges	Fees
Government Pharmacy Colleges	Tuition Fee: Rs. 25,000/- Per Annum
Self Financing Colleges	Tuition Fee : Rs. 1,55,000 Per Annum

The Commissioner for Entrance Examination will collect a token amount of Rs. 5,000/- from the candidates who got admission to Government colleges and government seats in Self Financing colleges. The balance amount of fee has to be remitted at the college concerned at the time of admission. **SC/ST/OEC candidates are exempted from payment of fees.** However they have to pay an amount of Rs.1,000/- as token of having accepted the allotment.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
