**Entrance Examination for Admission to PG Super  
Speciality Courses, Kerala - 2012**

**Rank list Published**

The Provisional Rank list and list of qualified Service candidates who have appeared for the Entrance Examination for admission to **Post Graduate Super Speciality Courses 2012** conducted on 23.06.2012, 24.06.2012 & 19.07.2012 at Thiruvananthapuram are published herewith.

While preparing the rank list, Eight questions in Medical Paper I, Eight questions in Surgical Paper I, One question in Neurology Paper II, One question in Nephrology Paper II, Two questions in Gastroenterology Surgery Paper II and Two questions in Re-conducted Cardiology Paper II have been deleted based on expert committee opinion sought with respect to the complaints raised by candidates regarding the questions/answer keys. These questions have not been included for valuation and no marks have been awarded for these deleted questions to any candidate. The total marks obtained for 82 questions have been multiplied by (90/82) in the case of Medical Paper I, the total marks obtained for 82 questions have been multiplied by (90/82) in the case of Surgical Paper I, the total marks obtained for 89 questions have been multiplied by (90/89) in the case of Neurology Paper II and so on to get the actual marks (corrected to four decimals). The above formula is applied to award proportionate marks based on the score of the candidates in the questions considered for valuation (excluding deleted questions) to compensate the loss of marks for the deleted questions. The answer keys of some of the questions also have been changed based on the expert committee opinion.

The Provisional Rank list will be available for reference in this office and on the website **www.cee-kerala.org**. The revised answer keys of all the papers are also published in the website.

Inclusion of a candidate in the rank list does not entitle him/her for admission to the courses, unless he/she satisfies the eligibility conditions contained in the Government approved Prospectus. The Director of Medical Education will make allotment and admissions as per the conditions laid down in the Prospectus.
