CAP - PGM 2007

At Adhyapaka Bhavan, Thiruvananthapuram on 16.09.2007

Procedure of allotment and Admission on 16-9-2007

1. **This Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) for admission to PG Medical Courses , 2007 is conducted on the basis of the order dated 7.9.2007 of the Honorable Supreme Court of India.**
2. Candidates have to register at the Registration Counter and affix their signature in the list provided in the counter. Preference forms will be supplied to the candidates to exercise their options.
3. Candidates will be called strictly in the order of their Rank for allotment. The admission status of a candidate (whether allotted earlier/not) will be verified. If a fresh candidate, (who had not turned up for the CAP conducted on 14.05.2007) comes, his documents will be verified before allotment.
4. Based on availability of seats a candidate will be allotted a seat as per his/her request. If the candidate is not interested he/she will be permitted to leave the CAP venue after giving a declaration to the effect that he/she is not interested either in the vacant seats or in the seats that may arise subsequently during the CAP.
5. (a) If the candidate taking allotment is already having an admission in a medical college in Kerala, he/she will be directed to the officials of the newly allotted college to get the slip regarding the amount of fee to be paid .
(b) If newly allotted, the candidate will be directed to the authorities of the allotted institution.
6. Fee amount will be collected by Canara Bank (The Bank will function in the CAP premises).

7. After remitting the fee amount the candidate has to complete the admission formalities.
- (a) The required original documents/certificates will be collected from the candidate.
- (b) The candidate has to execute a bond / give a declaration to the effect that he/she will execute the bond on or before 23.09.2007. The candidate can leave the CAP venue now, if he /she is not interested in the vacancies that may arise subsequently, during CAP.
8. In the absence of suitable SC/ST candidates for the seats under reserved category, those seats will be merged with the general merit seats.
9. Allotment of seats that may arise subsequently during CAP: The notified vacant seats will be filled up initially. Vacancies may arise during the allotment process due to fresh admissions to the candidates who are already admitted in the medical colleges of Kerala. Such arising vacancies will be open to all candidates appearing for the CAP and will be allotted subsequently on the same day and strictly on the basis of rank.
10. The allotment Process will be continued till the completion of allotment to all vacant seats, including those generated during the CAP as mentioned above, or all the candidates have exercised their choice .
