NOTIFICATION

As per the Government order GO(Rt) No.1740/2011/H&FWD Dated, 03/05/2011 in compliance with the Order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated29/04/2011 in SLP(CC) 6856853/2011 an entrance examination for the in-service candidates for admission to Medical Post Graduate (Degree/Diploma) Courses,2011 will be conducted at Thiruvananthapuram on 29/05/2011 by The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, in order to fill the unfilled seats for in-service candidates

The applications of the in-service candidates having the minimum qualifying service as stipulated in the Prospectus and already applied for Service-quota seats through proper channel will be forwarded by The Director of Medical Education to The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

The scheme of examination will be the same as stipulated in the Prospectus approved by the Government vide GO(Rt) No.41/2011/H&FWD dated 04/01/2011. It will consist of two Papers, each of two hours duration and having 150 Objective Type (Multiple Choice) Questions each. A minimum of 50% marks in the Entrance Examination is mandatory to become eligible for admission as per the Medical Council regulations. In case of candidates belonging to SC/ST and SEBC the required minimum marks in the Entrance Examination is 40% and in case of candidates with locomotory disabilities of lower limbs between 40% and 70%, the required minimum marks shall be 45%.

The CEE will conduct the Entrance Examination, prepare and publish the rank list of Candidates who qualify in the Entrance Examination and forward the same to the Director of Medical Education. The rank list will be made available in the website "www.cee-kerala.org".

The selection, admission and allotment of seats will be made by the DME through a Centralized Allotment Process [CAP] and will be based on various provisions laid down in the Prospectus approved by the Government of Kerala and as per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
