ALLOTMENT TO THREE YEAR LLB COURSE 2018-19 SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

AVAILABILITY OF WEBSITE FOR ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION AND RE-ARRANGEMENT

The activities related to the Second and Final phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Three Year LL.B Course in the 4 Government Law Colleges and 7 Private Self-financing Law Colleges in the State for the year 2018-19 commenced on **04.10.2018 (Thursday)**.

Candidates who are having valid options and who are willing to participate in this phase of allotment must compulsorily confirm their online options, by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in their home page. After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange the existing higher options. The facility for option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement will be available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **04.10.2018 to 06.10.2018, 3 pm**. **Those who do not confirm their higher options online within the stipulated time will not be considered for this phase of allotment.** The requests for option confirmation/re-arrangement/deletion of options received via Post/Fax/e-mail will not be considered.

Colleges	Fees
Government Law Colleges	Annual Tuition Fee - Rs.1500/-
Private Self Financing Law College (Govt. Seats)	Annual Tuition Fee - Rs.20,000/- + Refundable Deposit - Rs. 50,000/-

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Government Order detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Candidates who do not take admission on the specified dates will lose their existing allotment.

Candidates who receive allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment, should get the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted as tuition fee and refundable deposit at the time of admission from their present colleges and join the newly allotted colleges on the above specified dates, failing which they will lose their current admission also.
