

## NOTIFICATION ALLOTMENT TO B.PHARM (LE) COURSE 2018-19 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The Centralised Allotment Process for admission to B.Pharm (LE) Course in Government Pharmacy Colleges and Private Self-financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2018-19 will commences on 19/09/2018 (Wednesday).

Candidates included in the rank list can register their options online through the website <a href="www.cee.kerala.gov.in">www.cee.kerala.gov.in</a> from 19/09/2018 to 23/09/2018, 5 pm. [See Clause 11 of the Prospectus]. Candidate may enter their Application Number & Password in the link 'B.Pharm(LE) 2018 Candidate Portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' candidates can register their options online. The first allotment based on the online options received upto 5 pm on 23/09/2018 will be published on 24/09/2018. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges from 25/09/2018 to 27/09/2018.

Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clause 4** of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

## Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- (a) Admit Card of B Pharm Lateral Entry course 2018
- (b) S.S.L.C book or any equivalent school records to prove date of birth.
- (c) Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended and Conduct Certificate.
- (d) Mark list of D Pharm Part-I and Part II examinations
- (e) Diploma in Pharmacy certificate from the Board of D.Pharm Examination, Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Kerala or any other Board/University approved by Pharmacy Council of India.
- (f) Certificate of Registration with the State Pharmacy Council or receipt of submission of application for registration with State Pharmacy Council.
- (g) Migration Certificate
- (h) Physical Fitness Certificate in the relevant format given in Annexure VIII of the Prospectus B Pharm Lateral Entry course 2018,
- (i) Data sheet of B Pharm Lateral Entry course 2018,
- (j) Allotment Memo issued by the CEE.
- (k) Any other documents required by the Head of Institution.
- (l) The 'fee' as prescribed by the University concerned to the course will have to be remitted by the candidate at the time of taking admission in the college

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
