SECOND ALLOTMENT TO B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE 2019-20 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The second phase of the Centralized Allotment Process for admission to B.Pharm (Lateral Entry) Course in the Government Pharmacy Colleges and Private Self-financing Pharmacy Colleges of the State for the year 2019-20 commenced on **06.11.2019** (Wednesday). Candidates who have already submitted online options and who want to participate in this phase of allotment must compulsorily confirm their existing options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in their home page. After online option confirmation, such candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can rearrange their existing higher options. In addition, all the eligible candidates can register fresh options to the following 3 newly included self-financing pharmacy colleges.

The facility for online option confirmation/ deletion/ rearrangement/filing of fresh options will be available on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 06.11.2019 to 11.11.2019, 4 pm. Those who do not confirm their options online within the stipulated time will not be considered for this phase of allotment.

Candidate may enter their Application Number & Password in the link 'B.Pharm(LE) 2019 - Candidate Portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' candidates can register their options online. The allotment based on the online options received up to 4.00 pm on 11.11.2019 will be published on 12.11.2019. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges from 13.11.2019 to 15.11.2019, 5 pm.

Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

The annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Government Order detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clause 4** of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- i) Candidate's Data Sheet.
- ii) Allotment memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- iii) SSLC or any relevant school records/birth certificate/passport/other valid document to prove date of birth in original.
- iv) Mark list of D.pharm Part I and Part II examination.
- v) Diploma in Pharmacy Certificate from the 'Board of Diploma in Pharmacy Examination', Directorate of Medical Education, Government of Kerala/any other Board/University approved by Pharmacy Council of India.
- vi) Registration Certificate from the State Pharmacy Council of Receipt of submission of application for registration with State Pharmacy Council.
- vii) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution where the Candidate studied last.
- viii) Two copies of recent passport size photograph.
- ix) Candidate who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the state shall produce an "Eligibility Certificate" from the concerned university in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognized by the University.
- x) The student who qualifies from other Universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.
- xi) Originals of all the uploaded documents/certificates (to prove nativity /reservation/fee concession).
- xii) Any other certificates/documents required to be furnished as per the prospectus/notifications/allotment memo.

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Candidates are advised not to give unnecessary options to colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted. All details related to the allotment process are available on the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u>.
