<u>NOTIFICATION</u> CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT TO LL.M COURSE 2018-19 ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The Centralised Allotment for admission to LL.M Course in Government Law Colleges and Private Self Financing Law Colleges in the State for the year 2018-19 is published herewith on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in.**

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their **Application Number** and **Password** in the '<u>LL.M 2018-Candidate Portal</u>' provided in the website. Then by clicking the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can download their Allotment Memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fee etc. are available in the Allotment Memo. Candidate shall have to take a print out of the Allotment Memo and produce it before the College Authorities at the time of admission. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the link 'Data Sheet' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should report for admission before the Principal of the allotted college on any date from **18.03.2019** to **20.03.2019**, **4** pm along with the Allotment Memo and original documents specified in Clause 20 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per Government orders in the allotted college at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5.30 p.m. on 20.03.2019**.

The candidates who do not join the college on the specified dates, will lose their present allotment and also the higher order options. Their existing options will not be considered for further online allotments, if any.
