SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO PG HOMOEOPATHIC COURSES (MD)-2019-20 FACILITY FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION

The activities related to the second phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Homoeopathic Courses (MD) for the year 2019 has been commenced. All the processes related to this allotment will be done online.

The seats left vacant in Government Homoeopathic Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode after the first phase allotment will be filled through online allotment in the second phase.

Candidates can submit online option for any of the seats in above mentioned Homoeopathic Medical Colleges. Those students who have already got allotment in any of the Homoeopathic Colleges through the first phase allotment can also submit online options to be considered for second phase of online allotment.

Candidates included in the rank list published by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations can register their online options through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 15-10-2019 to 18-10-2019. Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link 'PG Homoeo2019-Candidate portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'option Registration' candidates can register their options. The second allotment based on the online options received up to 12.00am on 18-10-2019 will be published on 19-10-2019. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges from 21-10-2019 to 24-10-2019.

21.10.2019- 24-10-2019 5pm	Candidates to join the allotted colleges.
24 .10.2019 5.30 pm	Heads of Institutions to submit non-join report through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) to the office of CEE

Candidates allotted to the courses/ college should remit the fee mentioned in the allotment slip at the college allotted and take admission as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further allotments, if any.

SC/ST/OEC/candidates/children of Registered Fishermen/inmates of Srichitra Home, Nirbhayas Home, GOVT Juvenile Justice Homes alloted against merit seats are exempted from payment of fees.
