## SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MEDICAL & ALLIED COURSES PUBLISHED

The second phase allotment to Medical & Allied Courses in Kerala -2015 is published herewith on the website <a href="www.cee.kerala.gov.in">www.cee.kerala.gov.in</a>. Allotments only to Medical & Allied Courses have been done in this phase. Those students who had confirmed their options online within the stipulated time have alone been considered for the second phase allotment to Medical & Allied Courses.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate. The candidates should take a printout of the allotment memo pertaining to the second phase allotment to Medical & Allied courses and produce it before the authorities of State Bank of Travancore (SBT) for payment of fee/balance fee. The list of designated branches of SBT is available on the website.

Those candidates who receive an allotment afresh should remit the fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the allotment memo at any of the designated branches of State Bank of Travancore on any date from 29.07.2015 to 01.08.2015 and should join the course/college allotted before 5 pm on 01.08.2015.

The candidates who get a change in allotment than that of the previous allotment should pay the balance fee, if applicable, in a designated branch of SBT on any date from 29.07.2015 to 01.08.2015 and should join the course/college allotted as per the allotment memo before 5 pm on 01.08.2015.

Thus all the candidates who have an allotment under Medical & Allied courses should join the course/college allotted before 5 pm on 01.08.2015.

Those candidates who do not remit the fee/balance fee within the stipulated time and who do not join the course/college allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment and also their existing higher options under Medical & Allied courses.
