## ADMISSION TO MEDICAL P G (DEGREE / DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA-2016 REVISED SCHEDULE FOR SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The option registration facility to the second phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2016 is extended up to 3 PM on 19.05.2016 for providing option registration facility to the Government seats in Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur as per Government letter No. 15616/S3/2015/H&FWD dated: 17.05.2016.

The eligible candidates in General and Service Quota can register/re-arrange their options on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 17.05.2016 to 19.05.2016, 3 pm. The candidates who are satisfied with the options already given need not register/re-arrange their options.

## Revised schedule:

13.05.2016	Website opened for enabling online option confirmation/re- arrangement/ deletion of existing options and for filing fresh options to newly included colleges and courses
19.05.2016 - 3 pm	Facility for option confirmation/ registration /re-arrangement / deletion of options ends.
20.05.2016 - 6 pm	Publication of second phase of allotment
21.05.2016 to 27.05.2016	All candidates who get an allotment shall remit the fee / balance fee as shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of State Bank of Travancore (SBT).
21.05.2016 to 27.05.2016, 5 pm	All candidates should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt.
27.05.2016	Principals of Colleges to submit non-joining report through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) to the office of CEE

Nine Government seats, one each in MS General Surgery, MD Respiratory Medicine, MD Anesthesia, MD Psychiatry, MS Orthopaedics, MD Emergency Medicine, MS Ophthalmology, Diploma in Obstetrics and Gynaecology and Diploma in Orthopaedics in Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, Kannur are yet to be recognized by the Medical Council of India, this year. Hence options may be filed taking into consideration of the recognition status of these courses.
