Entrance Examination for admission to PG Medical Courses 2011 for in-service candidates—submitting of SEBC,SC,ST and P.D certificates for claiming marks relaxation—Reg.

As per the GO (Rt) No.1740/2011/H&FWD dated 03/05/2011 the entrance examination for in-service candidates for admission to PG Medical Courses, 2011 will be conducted at Thiruvananthapuram on 29/05/2011. The candidates who belong to SC/ST categories may submit a certificate in original showing the community duly issued as per service records by the controlling officer concerned for claiming relaxation in qualifying marks. The format for the same will be available on the website 'cee-kerala.org'.

Candidates claiming relaxation in marks under SEBC status should invariably produce both community and income certificates obtained from the revenue authorities concerned. Those whose annual family income is above Rs.4.5 lakhs are not eligible for relaxation in qualifying marks applicable to SEBC candidates. Only the claims of the candidates belonging to those communities that are included in the SEBC list as Annexure VIII in the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses, 2011 will be considered. Claims by candidates belonging to other communities, which are not included in the list, will be rejected even if certificates from the concerned Revenue Officers have been obtained and furnished. The minimum percentage of marks for eligibility for

admission to Postgraduate Medical courses, 2011 for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Socially and Educationally Backward Communities will be 40 %. For claiming the mark relaxation applicable to SEBC candidates who are children of Inter caste married couple, the candidate shall furnish an inter-caste Marriage Certificate from the Village officer in the proforma provided in the website. The father or the mother or both should belong to a Community included in the SEBC list for claiming the reservation benefits.

For claiming relaxation in qualifying marks under P.D category, an attested copy of the certificate of disability from the District Medical Board, certifying the degree of percentage of disability, issued not earlier than 3 months should be submitted to this office. The P.D.Candidates with locomotor disability of 40% to 70% need only 45% of marks to qualify in the entrance examination.

All the certificates should reach the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations on or before 23.05.2011, with a covering letter referring the application number allotted.
