ISSUE OF ADMIT CARD**

The Computer Based Test for the admission to Post Graduate Degree courses in Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing) - 2019 is scheduled be conducted on **01.09.2019 (Sunday)**. The CBT which had been announced to conduct on 10.08.2019 was postponed taking into account the adverse climate during the time.

The changes in the venues of examination may be noted. Rajadhani Institute of Engineering and Technology, Attingal Thiruvananthapuram, Federal Institute of Science and Technology(FISAT),Erankulam , ToCH Institute of Science and Technology Ernakulam, Sree Narayana Guru College of of Engineering and Technology Payyannur Kannur will be the centers for CBT.

The candidates can download their admit cards from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 22.08.2019 onwards. Candidates without admit cards will not be allowed to enter the examination hall. In order to download the admit card, candidates should enter their **Application Number** and **Password** on the above web page available after clicking on the link **PG Nursing 2019- Candidate Portal** of the website, www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

Candidates were given time to verify the details and to rectify the defects if any in their online application form. The candidates with defective application can clear their 'Memo' in the 'Home page' by uploading required documents/certificates before 27.08.2019 4.00 pm and can download their respective admit cards. The documents submitted through email/post/by hand will not be considered for the claim of any reservation at any circumstance.

Candidates who have already received their admit card for the exam scheduled on 10.08.2019 must download the new one to be produced at the examination hall on 01-09-2019. It must be noted that the admit cards previously downloaded will not be valid.
