



Higher Education - Admission to Professional Degree Courses for the year 2009-2010 in the Self-financing Engineering Colleges - allotment of seats by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations-orders issued.

## ORDER

1. The Prospectus for Admission to Professional Degree Courses, Kerala 2009, has been approved by the Government vide GO read above.

As per Clause 1.6 of the Prospectus, "Allotment of seats from the State Rank Lists for all courses in Self- financing Colleges will be made in accordance with the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or Govt of Kerala/Govt of India/ as per the law in existence at the time of Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) and will be notified separately".

Government have entered into an Agreement with 42 Private Self Financing Engineering Colleges Managements in respect of Seat snaring, Tuition fees payable and collection of refundable deposits for the year 2009-10 in their Colleges. As provided in the agreement, the approval of the Fee Regulatory Committee constituted under The Kerala Professional Colleges or Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fee, Regulation of Admission, Fixation of Non Exploitative Fee and other measures to ensure equity and excellence in Professional Education) Act, 2006 in respect of the clauses in the agreement was sought. The Fee Regulatory Committee has communicated its approval of the agreement vide Letter read 2nd above. Among the 42 private Self Financing Engineering Colleges, 2 new Private Self Financing Colleges namely KMCT College of Engineering for Women, Calicut and U.K.F College of Engineering and Technology, Kollam have not obtained affiliation from concerned Universities and hence are hereby excluded from the list of Member Colleges entitled for exercising option by students. Accordingly sanction is hereby accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE) for including the 40 Private Self-financing Engineering Colleges, which have entered into Agreement with Government, in the list of institutions specified in Annexure 1, to which options for allotment can be given by students and allotments can be made by the CEE in the Academic year 2009-10.

The distribution of 50% of the seats in the 40 Private Self-financing Engineering Colleges and 50% of seats in Self-financing Engineering Colleges under Government control and 50% seats in Self-financing Engineering Colleges run by Universities in Kerala allotted by the CEE shall be as follows:

- (I) General Merit -64%
- (II) Socially & Educationally Backward Classes -26%
  - (a) Ezhava (EZ) 9%
  - (b) Muslim (MU) 8%
  - (c) Other Backward Hindu (BH) 5%
  - (d) Latin Catholic other than Anglo Indian (LC) 2%
  - (e) Other Backward Christian (BX) 1%
  - (f) Kudumbi (KU) 1%
- (III) Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe -10%
  - (a) Scheduled Caste (SC) 8%
  - (b) Scheduled Tribe (ST) 2%
    - TOTAL 100%
- 2. In the case of Private Self-financing Engineering Colleges, having Minority Status, 10% of the total seats shall be earmarked for allotment from among the members belonging to the Minority Community which runs the college, on the basis of merit. Allotment will be made by the CEE after getting Community Certificates issued by revenue authorities, from the eligible candidates in the Rank list. In such Colleges, allotment to the remaining seats earmarked to be filled up by Government, will be made by the CEE as per the pattern of distribution mentioned in the paragraph one above.
- 3. The fee structure applicable to the seats under the categories mentioned below in the 40 Private Self financing Engineering colleges for the year 2009-10 shall be as given below:

Candidates desiring allotment/admission to any of the 40 Private Self financing Engineering Colleges can seek only upto two allotments.

Candidates who get allotment to any of the 40 Private self-financing Engineering Colleges in the Second allotment will not be eligible for further allotments. Their existing higher options will be treated as invalid.

Candidates who join any of the 40 Private Self-financing Engineering Colleges based on the second allotment may cancel their admission on or before 14.08.2009, in which case the amount remitted by them would be refunded and all documents relating to their admission returned with out any penal consequences. However those

candidates who wish to cancel their admission after 14.08.2009 shall have to remit the entire course fee in the College concerned to receive back the documents submitted in the College.

4. Caution deposit: All candidates allotted to any of the 40 Private Self financing Engineering Colleges, except those belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories and those eligible for benefits as per G.O (MS) No.25/2005/SCSTDD, Dated: 20.06.2005 will have to remit Caution deposit at the rate of Rs.10,000/-.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories will have to remit provisional Caution Deposit at the rates existing in Government Colleges and applicable to the course to which the candidate is allotted as a token of having accepted the allotment.

The difference in the amount of Caution deposit receivable by the Management of Private Self financing Engineering Colleges at the rates payable, in case of SC/ST /OEC candidates will be paid by the Government.

5. Allotment to Self-financing Engineering Colleges run by Institutions under Government control (IHRD, LBS, CAPE, CCEX & SCT)

50% of the seats in the above Self- financing Engineering Colleges will be allotted by the CEE as per the reservation policy of the Government. (See paragraph one). In addition, 35% of seats under Management quota in these institutions (except SCT) will be allotted by the CEE on merit basis. In SCT College of Engineering run by the KSRTC, Thiruvananthapuram, in a idition to the 50% seats, 25% management quota seats will be allotted by the CEE on merit basis.

7. Allotment to Self Financing Engineering Colleges under the Universities in Kerala Fifty per cent of the seats in Self-financing Engineering Colleges under the Universities will be filled up by the CEE as per the reservation policy and fee structure applicable to Government Colleges. So also, 35 % of seats under management quota under these Institutions are earmarked to the CEE for allotment on merit basis with the following fee structure.

8. Caution deposit: All candidates allotted to Self financing Engineering Colleges under Government control /Universities, except those belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories and those eligible for benefits as per G.O (MS) No.25/2005/SCSTDD, Dated: 20.06.2005 will have to remit Caution deposit upto a maximum of Rs.5000/-.

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories will have to remit provisional Caution Deposit at the rates existing in Government Colleges and applicable to the course to which the candidate is allotted as a token of having accepted the allotment.

- 9. The entire tuition fee for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/ and candidates eligible for educational and monetary benefits under G.O (MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD dt. 20.06.2005, and allotted by the CEE to the Government quota seats will be paid by Government at the rates mentioned above.
- 10. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/ candidates eligible for benefits as per G.O.

(MS) 25/2005/SCSTDD., dated 20.06.2005, allotted to the 50% seats in any of the 40 Private Self-financing colleges and Self financing colleges under Government Control and Self financing colleges under the Universities shall remit a token amount as determined by the CEE as a token of having accepted the allotment. The entire tuition fees and such other amounts payable by Government shall be paid by Government to the concerned Managements. They need not remit the tuition fee during the allotment process.

11.Only those institutions/courses having approval from the AICTE and order of affiliation from the Universities concerned will be considered for allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, .
