ADMISSION TO THREE YEAR LLB COURSE 2017-18
SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The second and final phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Three year LL.B Courses in Government Law Colleges and Private Self Financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2017-18 is published herewith on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The allotment is based on the existing online options as of 5 pm on 23.09.2017.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, and password in the 'Three Year LL.B 2017 - Candidate Portal' provided in the website. Then by clicking the menu item 'Allotment Result' candidates can download their allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fees, deposit if any etc. are available in the allotment memo. The candidate shall take a print out of the allotment memo. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu Item 'Data Sheet' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should report for admission to the Principal of the allotted colleges on 25.09.2017 or 26.09.2017 along with the allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause.16 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per Government orders in the allotted college at the time of admission. All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) by 5.30 p.m. on 26.09.2017.

Candidates who do not take admission on the specified dates will lose their existing allotment.

Candidates who receive allotment to their higher options in the final phase of allotment, should get the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted as tuition fee and refundable deposit at the time of admission from their present colleges and join the newly allotted colleges on the above specified dates, failing which they will lose their current admission also.

Spot Allotment: The vacant seats, if any, remaining after 5 pm on 26.09.2017 shall be filled up through Spot Allotment/Admission to be conducted by the college authorities concerned on 27th or 28th of September 2017, strictly in accordance with the stipulations in clause 14 (xvii).10 of the Prospectus for admission to Three year LL.B Courses 2017-18.
