Documents to be produced at the time of Admission

- 2. Candidate's Data Sheet issued by the CEE.
- 3. Original Mark list of LL.B. examinations (All Mark Lists)
- 4. Provisional/Degree Certificate
- 5. Originals of the relevant Certificates to be produced
- 6. Any other documents mentioned in the Allotment Memo
- 7. Transfer certificate
- 8. Conduct certificate from the Head of the institution where the candidate studied last or from a Gazetted Officer, obtained within the last six months
- 9. Two copies of passport size photograph of the candidate
- 10. Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce "Eligibility Certificate/Equivalency Certificate" from a University in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognized by the University.
- 11. Applicant who is employed or a trainee in Government service, Scheduled Bank etc. should produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the office where the applicant is employed at the time of interview.

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims, if any, in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
