SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES, KERALA - 2014

The activities related to the second phase of Single Window System of allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2014 will commence from 29.04.2014 (Tuesday).

The candidates who have already joined in the course/college subsequent to the 1st phase of allotment and still holding the allotted seat can re-arrange/delete their higher order options on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 29.04.2014 to 02.05.2014, 5 pm.

29.04.2014	Website opens for enabling re-arrangement / deletion of higher order options.
02.05.2014 - 5 pm	Facility for re-arrangement / deletion of options ends.
03.05.2014	Publication of second phase of allotment
05.05.2014 to 09.05.2014	All candidates who get an allotment shall remit the fee / balance fee as shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of State Bank of Travancore (SBT).
05.05.2014 to 10.05.2014, 5 pm	All candidates should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt.
10.05.2014, 5.30 pm	Submission of Non-joining report by the College authorities before 5.30 pm.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

Candidates allotted to any courses, and who remit the fee/balance fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college/course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any.

The date of allotment and joining time shown above are in accordance with the schedule prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on its order dated 14.03.2014 and hence no extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities.
