Sub: Clarificatory directions issued to all the self financing Medical and Dental Colleges while admitting NRI candidates-Reg

The Non Resident Indian Seats are dealt with in section 2(o) of Act XIX of 2006.

Later, the Government of Kerala, has issued G.O(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013, which was again modified through G.O(MS)No.193/2013/H&FWD dated 22.05.2013. The Government has now issued G.O(MS)No. 243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, further elaborating the relationship of the NRI Sponsor and the candidate.

There are lot of doubts on the procedure to be followed by the Medical/Dental Colleges in admitting the NRI Students, which often causes difficulties to accept and approve the list of admitted candidates during scrutiny.

The ASC/FRC, after considering the G.O(MS)No.243/2014/H&WFD dated 06.08.2014, the various judgements of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala, including W.P(C)No.14708 of 2012 (K), Dr. Gowri raj Vs State of Kerala and 10 others, felt it necessary to issue the following clarificatory directions to all the Medical and Dental Colleges, who are conducting various courses for NRI Candidates:-

- A candidate, who apply for the NRI Seat should submit to the college the employment certificate of the sponsor, duly attested by the embassy/ consulate or their should be an endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment.
- 2. The certificates establishing the relationship between the candidate and the sponsor shall be obtained only from the concerned Thasildar/ Village

Officer, with the required details and corroborating documents, and mere statements by the Thasildar/ Village Officer stating the relationship shall not be accepted. The other certificate produced will be rejected.

- 3. However the relationships between the candidate and the father/mother, which are recorded in the educational register, maintained in the usual course of transactions by the competent authorities, shall be accepted when included in the certificate.
- 4. The candidate has to prove that he/she is the dependent of the sponsor.
- 5. All the certificates/documents required to establish NRI status/ SEBC /OBC/ Management seats etc. shall be produced at the admission stage itself.

Any document produced, at a later stage, shall only be rejected. This is required to maintain Academic Excellence and to prevent exploitation.

These directions shall come into force from the admissions of Medical/ Dental Courses in the academic year of 2014-15 onwards.
