ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, the Prospectus for the Post-Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the academic year 2017-18, has

The Director of Medical Education, Thiruvananthapuram as per letters been approved. read as 3rd paper above has requested to modify the Prospectus for the Post-Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the academic year 2017-18, with certain modifications. Government examined the matter in detail and are pleased to modify the Prospectus for the Post-Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma Courses for the academic year 2017-18, with the following modifications.

- 1. In Clause 1, para 4 of the Prospectus, the first sentence is modified as follows: "In addition to the above, allotment to the 50% seats in the Non-Governmental Medical Colleges/Institutions will also be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination, Kerala on the basis of the NEET PG-2017 conducted by the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi subject to the eligibility conditions in Clause 4".
- 2. In Clause 1, box below para 4 is hereby deleted.
- 3. In Clause 4.3.2, the second sentence for those candidates for PG Diploma courses stands deleted.
- 4. In Clause 6.1 General Merit Quota, the first sentence is modified as follows: "Leaving the seats set apart for persons with Disabilities and Ex-Service quota, 81% of the remaining seats under State Quota will be allotted under General Merit, 10% of seats for SC/ST and 9% of seats to SEBC for Degree Courses".
- 5. Clause 6.5.12 (a) is modified as follows:
 - "6.5.12 (a): The eligibility criteria for the service quota are the same as laid down in Clause 4. The applicants under Service Quota should have completed a minimum period of 3 years on duty under regular appointment in difficult and remote areas as defined by Government to become eligible to apply for Post-Graduate diploma seats reserved for Health Service candidates. Provisional service if any, before the regular appointment will not be considered.

6. In Clause 6.5.13 under Note, Sl. No.1 is modified as follows: "The candidates who are applying only for Service Quota need not attach the certificates to prove Nativity as in Clause 7.2.4 below".

7. In Clause 9.1 weightage to service quota candidate in the second sentence Medical Education, Insurance Medical Service, Municipal Service is hereby

deleted.

8. In Clause 10.1.7, the last sentence is modified as follows: "The candidates must also have access to internet facility. The candidates should follow the procedure given below (Clause 10.1.9 – 10.1.15) for registering options"

9. In Clause 10.1.18 Spot Allotment, the third sentence is modified as follows: "A candidate who figures in the Rank list/Category lists prepared as per clause 9 of the Prospectus for Admission to Medical PG Degree/Diploma Courses-2017-18 but not joined under All India Quota seats alone is

entitled to attend the Spot allotment/admission process".

10. In Clause 12.1.(b), the first sentence is modified as follows: All the General Merit candidates including AIQ candidates admitted to Medical Post-Graduate Courses in Kerala shall serve the Government of Kerala in Medical Education Services as Senior Resident as decided by the DME/Principals of Colleges for continuous period of not less than one year immediately after the completion of the course without break. (Bonded Obligation can be fulfilled as service as Lecturer/Assistant Professor/Assistant Surgeon/Junior Consultant/Senior Resident).

11. Clause 12.2.1 is modified as follows: "If a Post Graduate student including Service candidates discontinues the P.G course after the final Centralized Allotment Process he/she shall have to pay a sum of ₹50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty Lakhs only) as Liquidated Damages to the Government of Kerala and

also refund the stipend/Salary already received".

12. In Clause 12.2.4, the first sentence is modified as follows: "If candidates including Service Candidates violate the terms mentioned in Clause 12-1.(b) above, it will be construed as Professional Misconduct and the fact reported to the Travancore Cochin Medical Council for suitable action including cancellation of Registration by the Council".

13. In Clause 12.2.5 the sentence begins with otherwise their admission is hereby cancelled and they are bound to pay the liquidated damages as mentioned in clause 13.2.4(i) is corrected as clause 12.2.1 and 12.2.4.

14. In Clause 12.2.6, after the first sentence it may be read as follows: "In the case of Service Candidates Parents/Guardian/Husband/Wife shall be stand as sureties. The signature of the candidate and the sureties have to be attested by a Gazette officer of State/Central Government or Grama/Block /District/Panchayath President/Municipal Chairperson/Mayor or MLA/MP, by countersigning in the bond agreement as a witness.

15. In Clause 12.2.9, second para first sentence is modified as follows, "If a Service Quota candidate discontinues the P.G Course or violate the conditions in the bond of service after the final Centralised Allotment Process he/she shall have to pay a sum of ₹50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) as Liquidated Damages to the Government of Kerala and also refund the stipend/Salary already received".

16. In Clause 12.2.9 add the following sentence: "The Principal should ensure that the conditions of the bond are the same as stipulated in the Prospectus including the period of bond and the amount of liquidated damages".

- 17. In Clause 14, second sentence is modified as follows: "Re-allotment will be considered only though Centralized Counseling before the closing of allotment process as per the Guidelines/directions of the Medical Council of India/Supreme Court of India".
- 18. In Annexure VIII, the footnote is modified as follows: "Witness must be a person as mentioned in the clause 12-2.6 of the Prospectus".
- 19. Annexure IX of the Prospectus is modified and appended to this Government Order.
- 20. Annexure V(b) of the Prospectus is modified and appended to this Government Order.
- 21. Annexure XIII is renumbered as Annexure XII
- 22. A new Annexure is included as Annexure XIII, which is the list of Other Eligible Communities (OEC) and appended to this Government Order.
- 23. Annexure XV, XVI and XVII are re-numbered as Annexure XIV, XV, XVI.
- 24. In Clause 3.5.1, Annexure XIV is modified as Annexure XIII.
- 25. In Clause 3.5.2, Annexure XV is modified as Annexure XIV.
- 26. In Clause 6.4.1(1), Annexure XII and XIII are modified as Annexure XI and XII, also the words X, E; Tahasildar' in the second sentence inside the box are hereby removed.
- 27. In Clause 6.5.3, Annexure XVII and Annexure VII are modified as Annexure XVI, and Annexure VI respectively.
- 28.In Clause 6.5.7, Annexure XVII and Annexure VIII are modified as Annexure XVI and Annexure VII.
- 29. In Clause 6.5.1 and 6.5.9, Annexure VII is modified as Annexure VI.
- 30. In Clause 7.2.4, under Section 2 and 3 Annexure XV is modified as
- 31.In Clause 12.2.5 the last sentence is modified as follows" "A copy of the same is also annexed as VIII and IX".

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expenses on condition that after successful completion of the course of study within the prescribed period the bounden shall serve the Government for a period of *** and also subject to the terms and conditions here in after appearing and the bounden and the sureties have agreed to the same.

NOW the condition of the above written obligation is that in the event the Bounden after successful completion of the Post Graduate course of study to which he was selected, fails to serve the Government for a period of ***, the Bounden and shall forthwith pay to the Government on demand the sum of Rs................................(the total amount of salary/stipend Drawn during the period of Study) and **in addition to the amount spend by government for their studies with interest as fixed by Government towards liquidated damages for violation of the conditions in clause12.2 of the Medical PG Prospectus 2017. In the matter of deciding what moneys are to be paid by the Bounden and the sureties and decision of the Government shall be final and legally binding on the bounden and sureties and upon the payment of such sum the above written obligation shall be void and of no effect otherwise this shall be remaining full force and effect.

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that if the Bounden fails to serve the Government for a period of *** years, it may be construed as professional misconduct and the fact reported to the TC Medical Council for suitable action including cancellation of Registration by the council.

PROVIDED further that the bounden and the sureties do hereby agree that all sums found due to the Government under or by virtue of this bond may be recovered jointly and severely from them and their properties movable and immovable as if such dues were arrears of land revenue under the provisions of the Revenue Recovery Act for the time being force or in such other manner as the Government may deem fit.

THE liabilities of the sureties under this Bond is Co-existent with that of the Bounden and shall not be affected by the Government giving time or any other indigence to the bounden or by the Government varying of the terms and conditions here in contained,

It is agreed that the certificates submitted at the time of admission will be released by the Principal only after satisfactorily completing the bonded obligation.

- For service candidates admitted after having received the benefit of weightage marks only, 10 years in the service of Government (station to which to be posted will be decided by the DHS, from time to time) or till superannuation whichever is earlier.
