Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 4 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of Admission

- 1. Candidate's Data Sheet.
- 2. Allotment Memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- 3. Original Mark list of LL.B. examinations (All Mark Lists)
- 4. Provisional/Degree Certificate
- 5. Any other documents mentioned in the Allotment Memo
- 6. Transfer certificate
- 7. Conduct certificate from the Head of the institution where the candidate studied last or from a Gazetted Officer, obtained within the last six months
- 8. Four copies of passport size photograph of the candidate
- 9. Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce "Eligibility Certificate/Equivalency Certificate" from a University in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognized by the University.
- 10. Applicant who is employed or a trainee in Government service, Scheduled Bank etc. should produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the office where the applicant is employed at the time of interview.
- 11. Originals of all the documents/certificates uploaded along with the online application (to prove nativity /reservation/fee concession).

Note:

- 1) <u>Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.</u>
- 2) The candidates whose results in the respective rank lists have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they Upload the required documents to clear the defects and release their ranks before 4 pm on 04.03.2020.
- 3) Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their further claims, if any, in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
