ADMISSION TO P G MEDICAL (DEGREE / DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA-2018 MOP-UP COUNSELING & ADMISSION TO VACANT SEATS

A Mop-Up Counseling to fill up the vacant seats in P G Medical courses - 2018 in Government/Self Financing Medical colleges will be conducted at 9.30 am on **14/05/2018** at the **C.O. Karunakaran Auditorium, Government Medical College campus, Thiruvananthapuram.**

After including the newly registered candidates as per notification of this office even No. dated 28/04/2018, a Revised Kerala State Rank list has been prepared by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and was published on 06/05/2018. Candidates included in the Revised Kerala State Rank list alone will be eligible for participating in the Mop-Up Counseling process. All candidates in the above rank list can register and download a **Mop-Up Registration Slip** available from 12/05/2018, 5pm from the above portal. The **Mop-Up Registration Slip** is mandatory for a candidate to participate in the Mop-Up Counseling process.

Guidelines for Mop-Up Counseling & Admission

- 1) The Mop-Up Counseling and Admission will be based on the Revised Kerala State Rank list published vide Notification dated 06/05/2018.
- 2) The Mop-Up Counseling will be followed by admission process at the Mop-Up Counseling venue and hence the **candidates must be present in person** for Mop-Up Counseling with all the required documents and applicable fees.
- 3) The Candidates who have joined PG Course in State quota in Second Phase Allotment shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop-Up Round. The DGHS, New Delhi has given a list of candidates who are admitted in the seats of All India Quota. Those candidates are also not eligible to participate in the Mop-Up Round
- 4) The candidates who have joined PG Course in State quota on exit, after being allotted to the seats in the second round will have to forfeit 10% of the annual fee if they do not join the course i.e., the exit shall be allowed on forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee during the second round and if they have joined the course they will not be eligible for further counseling. In case the applicant retains the seat in the first phase and he/she is not allotted any seats in the second phase then this allotment in the first phase will be considered as equivalent to the seat allotted in second phase and he/she will have to forfeit 10% of annual fee, if he/she decides to quit before the last date of surrender of seat already allotted. **The last date for surrender of seat is 11/05/2018, 5pm.**
- 5) Candidates (except SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen) getting fresh admission to any Government Medical college through Mop-Up counseling shall have to produce a Demand Draft for Rs. 50,000/- for Degree Courses and Rs. 45000/- for Diploma Courses drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram at the time of allotment. A candidate getting fresh allotment in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges for Degree/Diploma Courses shall have to remit Rs. 5,00,000 (Five lakhs) by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, payable at Thiruvananthapuram. Remaining fees shall have to be remitted in the allotted college. For an SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen, candidate allotted to a Government Medical College or Government seats in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges (Except Management, NRI/ Minority Community seats), the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be **Rs.1000/-** (Rupees One Thousand only). However a candidate who has already paid tuition fees to the CEE during the first or second phase of allotment need to pay only the balance amount, if any, during this Mop-Up Counseling.

- 6) All vacant seats reported by the colleges concerned/DME at 5.30 pm on 11/05/2018 due to non-joining / issue of TC will be included in the Mop-Up counseling.
- 7) Those candidate including SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen who are allotted but not joined in a course in the Second Phase of Allotment can participate in the Mop-Up round by forfeiting an amount equal to 10% of annual fee of the College/Course allotted in the Second Phase. Exit fee can be paid by way of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations payable at Thiruvananthapuram and the original Demand Draft should be produced at the Mop-up counseling venue.
- 8) SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen candidates are not exempted from remittance of exit fee and the exit fee for SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen candidates will be at par with that of General Candidates.
- 9) SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen candidates allotted to a seat in Management, NRI/ Minority Community seats in Private Self Financing Medical College shall have to pay the fees fixed for that seat.

Documents to be produced at the time of Mop-Up Round Counseling

1. Mop-Up Round slip.
2. NEET-PG 2018 score sheet.
3. Originals of all the Uploaded documents.
4. Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate.
5. Admit card issued by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi
6. Document to prove date of birth
7. Pass/Degree certificate in the qualifying examination. (MBBS Degree)
8. Permanent Registration Certificate from the T.C Medical Council.
9. CRRl Certificate.
10. Certificate of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate from KUHS for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination (MBBS Degree) from outside Kerala.
11. Demand Draft for token amount/Tuition fee to be paid to CEE.
12. Demand Draft for exit fee, if applicable.

NOTE:-

- a) The candidates who are allotted with a seat in the Mop-Up Round and who discontinues the course on any reason after the Mop-Up Counseling shall be liable to pay 50 lakhs as the liquidated damages as per Clause 12-2 of the prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses 2018.
- b) The vacant seats in Government/ Private Self Financing Medical colleges after the second phase of counseling will be published on the website on 12/05/2018.
