<u>NOTIFICATION</u> B.PHARM (LATERAL ENTRY) COURSE ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS -2020

- 1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination for admission to B. Pharm Course [through Lateral Entry] for the year, 2020 in the Government and Private-Self financing Pharmacy Colleges.
- 2. Eligibility for Admission

Nativity: Applicant should be an Indian citizen of Kerala origin.

<u>Academic qualifications</u>: Candidates should have studied Diploma in Pharmacy (Under Education Regulations 1991 of Pharmacy Council of India) in an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India and have passed the Diploma in Pharmacy examination conducted by the State Board of D Pharm Examinations or equivalent with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks for the D. Pharm part I and D. Pharm II Examinations.

Candidates should have obtained registration with Pharmacy Council and the registration Certificate is to be produced at the time of Counselling.

Age: There is no upper age limit for admission to the course.

- 3. Selection on the basis of Entrance Examination: Selection of candidates for B.pharm (Lateral entry) course 2020 will be made on the basis of a Computer Based Test to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, [CEE] at Thiruvananthapuram and Thrissur on 11.04.2021 (Sunday). It will consist of one Paper of one and half hrs (90 minutes) duration and will have 120 Objective Type (Multiple Choice) Questions.
- 4. Submission of Applications and Application Fee: All candidates seeking admission to B.pharm (Lateral entry) course 2020 can apply in the Online application form available from 17.03.2021 provided in the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at Head Post Offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee, the candidate should upload photo and signature and all necessary certificates /Documents. No need to send printout of the application or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Application Fee for General Candidates is **Rs.800/-** (Rupees Eight hundred only) and for SC candidates is **Rs.400/-** (Rupees Four hundred only). ST Candidates are exempted from the payment of application fee. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. Application form will not be available in the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations or office of the DME. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u>.

- 5. Last date and time for online submission of application: All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in clause 7.3.5 of the prospectus before 5 pm of 28.03.2021. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Candidates have to take a printout of the online application form for future reference.
- 6. Admit Cards : Admit cards for the candidates whose Applications have been accepted will be provided in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> from 02.04.2021
- 7. Entrance Examination: The scheme of Computer Based Test, syllabus and the instructions to the candidates are available in clause 8 of the "Prospectus for Admission to B.pharm (Lateral entry) course 2020" approved by Government of Kerala.
- 8. Rank List: CEE will conduct the Entrance Examination and will publish the Rank list of candidates as per the provisions in clause 10 of the Prospectus for Admission to B.Pharm (Lateral entry) course 2020 approved by Government of Kerala.
- **9**. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/Documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application.
- 10. Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to B.pharm (Lateral entry) course 2020 available on the Official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> before filling up the Online application forms.
