SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO PG NURSING COURSES (MSc Nursing)-2019-20 FACILITY FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION/OPTION CONFIRMATION

The activities related to the second phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Nursing Courses (MSc. Nursing) for the year 2019 has been commenced. In this phase allotment is done for the vacant seats in Government Nursing colleges, Private Self Financing Colleges included in the first phase of allotment.

Candidates who have already submitted online options and who want to participate in this phase of allotment must compulsorily confirm their existing options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in his/her home page. After online option confirmation, such candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange their existing higher options. The facility for online option confirmation /deletion/re-arrangement will be available on the Website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from to 23.09.2019 to 26.09.2019, 12.00 noon. Those who do not confirm their options online within the stipulated time, will not be considered for this phase of allotment.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

23 .09.2019	Website opens for enabling online option confirmation/re- arrangement/ deletion of existing options / filing fresh options to the newly included colleges and courses.
26 .09.2019 - 12.00 noon	Facility for online option confirmation/re-arrangement / deletion of options ends.
26.09.2019	Publication of second phase of allotment
27.09.2019- 30-09-2019 5pm	All candidates who get allotment shall remit the fee as shown in the allotment memo at the colleges and join the course.
30 .09.2019	Heads of Institutions to submit non-join report through Online

Candidates allotted to the courses/ college should remit the fee mentioned in the allotment slip at the college allotted and take admission as per the schedule prescribed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further allotments, if any.
